

## Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

### THE POWER OF ONE

Back in the year 2011, the Church's liturgy underwent a linguistic change. That year, on the First Sunday of Advent, the new translation of the Roman Mass came into effect. We are now more than familiar with, "The Lord be with you", and "And with your spirit". What at the time seemed difficult to adjust to has now become second nature. There were other linguistic changes as well. And, the changes were solely in the words, not in the structure or order or practice of the Mass. In other words, nothing was added or removed.

This came about at the instigation of Pope Benedict XVI at the time. In the late 1960's, the Latin Rite of the Church was translated into native languages from the original Latin. The translation was undertaken to incorporate the "broad spirit" of the translation. In other words, it was not exact. Pope Benedict asked that the liturgy in the various native (or vernacular) languages be as close to the original Latin as possible. This is why we have "And with your spirit". It is much closer to Latin than "And also with you". This shows itself in the Opening Prayers, the Creed, and the Eucharistic prayers. For example, the word "cup" is never used in the original Latin, but always "chalice".

Just several weeks ago, we experienced a new change, albeit one you have probably not recognized. In the English translation, the Collect (or Opening Prayer) of the Mass always ended with "We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever". Now, a single simple word has been eliminated, the word "one". It is always meant and implied that God is One, so the word which does not appear in the Latin has been eliminated. Just keeping you up to date on the ever-evolving liturgy of the Church!

**SAINT OF THE WEEK:** Saint Turibius of Mogrovejo (March 23)

St. Turibius began his lay career as a lawyer in the famous "law" city of Salamanca, Spain. He eventually was ordained a priest, and in the late 1500's named Bishop of Lima, Peru. He traveled to the new world where he lived out his life, dying in 1606. He founded the first seminary in the Western Hemisphere. He was also known as a friend to the poor, constantly advocating on their behalf, and serving them in charity. He is a contemporary of St. Rose of Lima and St. Martin de Porres, also of Lima. He is patron saint of Latin American bishops.



### Fifth Sunday of Lent

Everybody clings to stuff. We cling to our mothers on the first day of kindergarten. We mark off our sacred chair, or crayon box, or the line of demarcation in our shared bedrooms. This is mine. You're not allowed to touch this, or borrow that, or go beyond this point.

Winter makes its mark on us. We pull our coats tighter, and tie our scarves close to our necks. The wind howls, the bare trees stand as silent witness to death. The earth, cold as iron, closes up and offers no hint of the miracle going on just underneath.

The grain of wheat tries to cling too. Hidden in darkness and cold, it tries to hold on to its color and shape. The baby, safe and warm, clings to the womb. But oh, what wondrous life the Master Designer has encoded in us. The grain breaks open—painful death! The baby pushes out of the womb—terrifying! And then comes the Great Reveal: we were never meant to stay a grain of wheat, or a child in the womb.

Staying where we are just doesn't fit the pattern that God set up in order for us to thrive. That grain of wheat won't feed the world if it's allowed to cling. If seeds don't die, then birds and insects and animals and humans can't live. If a baby remains in the womb, mother and child will die. The DNA God imprinted in us requires that we not hold on forever. God has greater plans.

We cling to this life because it's all we know. And yet, season after season, God tells a different story. Keep your spring clothes handy. Resurrection is afoot.

Some of the largest chocolate companies, including Nestle, Hershey and Godiva, have the worst record. AND exposure to toxic pesticides has increased. Despite chocolate being a \$100 billion per year industry, cocoa farmers make less than \$1 per day. Fair Trade chocolate guarantees that no child labor was used in the growing and harvesting, and addresses the problems of cocoa farmer poverty, pesticide use and deforestation. You can order Fair Trade chocolate and many other items up until midnight **on April 12th for pick up on April 24th**. Special note to those parishioners making sack lunches for the homeless shelters, a couple of mini chocolates in the lunch can brighten someone's day and support Fair Trade farmers at the same time.


