## Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

### THE JOYS AND SORROWS OF HOLY WEEK

Today we celebrate the Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion. This is also the beginning of the most solemn and Holy Week of the year. The week is book-ended with joy: the triumphal welcome of Christ into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday leads to Easter joy. In between, we celebrate those solemn and richly spiritual days of the Triduum.


On Palm Sunday, we remind ourselves that the joyful welcome of Christ quickly turns to sorrow, sadness and even betrayal. The reading of the Passion on Palm Sunday reminds us of our own sinfulness, made repentant and reconciled in the Passion and Death of Christ on the cross. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday are days of prayer. Holy Thursday ushers in the Triduum (Three Days) and commemorates the Last Supper and the Gift of the Eucharist. This is a day on which only the "Evening Mass" may be celebrated. It is also at the Holy Thursday Mass where the foot-washing occurs. This marks the very event at the Last Supper where Christ modelled servant discipleship to his apostles by washing their feet.

Good Friday is the most solemn day of the Church year. It is the day of Christ's death and crucifixion. Mass is not celebrated on Good Friday. The Solemn Service is traditionally

held at 3:00pm in the afternoon (the traditional time of Christ's death). It is a very powerful moment in which all the people of the vast Church celebrate at the same time with the same prayers. It shows our unity in the very death of Christ.

Saturday is the day of Christ's lying in the tomb..a day of prayer and contemplation with no Mass celebrated. This leads to the great celebration of the Easter Vigil (which begins after sunset). The Easter Vigil is the highest liturgy of the Church's year. It follows the whole of salvation history to the moment of Christ's triumph. It is truly the Paschal Mystery unfolding before us. It is also the Mass at which the unbaptized enter the Church and receive their "death with Christ" through baptismal waters. For all of the Triduum, confessions are not scheduled and are only heard in emergency (life and death) situations.

Easter dawns with joy and celebration. As Mary Magdalene went to the tomb that Easter morn, we too go to church to join our voices in the triumphant song of resurrection. Christ is risen, he is truly risen!

### Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

What did Jesus know, and when did he know it? That question can haunt us as we hear the Passion read, and as we meditate throughout this Holy Week. Did he always know that he would die?

He must have known by the time of the transfiguration at Tabor. When Moses and Elijah appeared in the cloud, they spoke with him. He must have known then that his life was coming to an end.

I'm sure he must have known by the night of the Last Supper. Judas must have been behaving oddly. Even some people in Jerusalem could have been whispering, loud enough for him to hear, that someone had betrayed him. When Jesus told the Twelve that the hour of his death was upon him, their behavior must have confirmed what his heart already knew.

The arrest followed, and the night spent in Caiaphas' dungeon. There was the sentence of death, the terrible scourging, and, finally, the cross. Mark records that his last were, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" This is the very worst part. Nothing is as terrible as our Jesus crying out in despair, asking why God has abandoned him.

And then it is complete. The ultimate passion—to have his Father's face turned from him—is finally finished. If he had had the comfort and intimacy of the Father with him on the cross, it would not have been the cross.

There may be a time this year that in your greatest hour of darkness you cannot find Jesus. Remember, then, that Jesus knows what that loneliness is. You have been given a share in his cross.

So, likewise, in his resurrection.

What parts of the Passion resonate with an experience in your own life?


