Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

EASTER JOY

St. Augustine once famously said that "Christians are an Easter people and Alleluia is their song". What the eminent saint of the early Middle Ages was pointing out was that we are a people with Alleluia-Christ is Risen in our heart, not just today of all days, but everyday. It was common in the early days of the Church for people to alter their daily greeting to each other during the Easter Season. One would greet another with "Christ is risen", and the respondent would reply "He is truly risen". It is quite stunning in a world that worries of offending with "Merry Christmas", how our ancestors in the faith had "Alleluia" so easily on their lips.

Easter is a time of new birth, refreshment, life and death defeating death and darkness. Christ is most prominent in our lives and the life of the Church during this blessed season. He is truly risen, and all his preparation and teaching reaches its fulfillment in this moment. When the Risen Christ speaks Mary Magdalene's name, a new relationship with the Risen Christ is forged for humanity. We are one with Him in his glory. And, our lives are never the same.

T.S. Eliot who famously wrote that "April was the cruelest month", also reflected on this amazing Easter miracle in his book of poetry, "Choruses from the Rock". He says,

"O Light invisible. we praise Thee! Too bright for our mortal vision.

O Greater Light, we praise Thee for the less; the eastern light our spires touch at morning, the light that slants upon our western doors at evening.

The twilight over stagnant pools at bat flight, moon light and star light, owl and moth light, glow-worm glow light on a grass blade. O Light Invisible, we worship Thee!

We thank Thee for the lights that have kindled, the light of the altar and sanctuary;


Small lights of those who meditate at midnight and lights directed through the coloured panes of windows, and light reflected from the polished stone, the gilded carven wood, the coloured fresco. Our gaze is submarine, our eyes look upward and see the light that fractures through unquiet water.

We see the light but see not whence it comes, O Light Invisible, we glorify Thee!

As a Christian "Alleluia" people, we know that the Light which is Christ comes from God above, and shows its glory in this wondrous Easter resurrection. How fortunate we are, how blessed, and honored. In response, we give thanks for Christ's great glory! He is truly risen yet again, and not just our speech but our very lives are altered.

"He is truly risen!"

This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad. (Ps 118)

Easter Sunday

Why didn't everyone living in Jerusalem see the Risen One? Acts says: God...granted that he be visible, not to all the people, but to us...(10: 40-41). I know that if I had seen Him hanging on the cross that awe-full Friday, I would have felt cheated that he didn't appear to me, RAISED and RADIANT, that glorious Sunday.

Even Peter and the Beloved Disciple, after racing to the tomb, left without actually SEEING Jesus. It was only Mary Magdalene, whose story follows today's gospel in John 10: 11-18, who actually saw him, and at first even she mis-took him for the gardener Balaam, the famous "seer," couldn't see God's huge angel right there in the road (Nm. 22). And Elisha's servant couldn't see God until Elisha prayed that God would open his eyes to see the hills full of angelic chariots all around (2 Kgs. 6:17).

Most telling of all, Jesus' own disciples spent Easter Sunday on the road with him and didn't recognize him until the Breaking of the Bread (Lk. 24: 13-35). Jesus eventually appeared to over five hundred believers, according to St. Paul, who admits he got the story from Peter (1 Cor. 15: 5-8). We have seen the Lord! they cried with joy. Lucky them.

But maybe he HAS appeared, to everyone who longed for him that day, and the billions who have longed for him since. Maybe we have felt his Presence, and sensed his nearness, countless times in our lives.

So let me ask you: who was that with you, in the Delivery Room, on your First Communion Day, at the graveside of a loved one? Ah. Of course. Lucky you. You have seen the Lord.

Where do you look for the Risen Lord these days?


STEWARDSHIP OF YOUR TITHE

Despite chocolate being a \$100 billion per year industry, cocoa farmers make less than \$1 per day. Fair Trade chocolate guarantees that no child labor was used in the growing and harvesting, and addresses the problems of cocoa farmer poverty, pesticide use and deforestation. You can order Fair Trade chocolate and many other items up until midnight **on April 12th for pick up on April 24th**. Special note to those parishioners making sack lunches for the homeless shelters, a couple of mini chocolates in the lunch can brighten someone's day and support Fair Trade farmers at the same time.


