Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

EASTER SEASON-A SPECIAL TIME

We humans tend to "move on". We celebrate something, e.g. a birthday, holiday, special event, and then we look to the next party! As Catholics, we take things a bit slower. We celebrate "octaves" (or 8 days) when we experience a major feast like Christmas or the Assumption. Sometimes, that celebration extends to a much longer season, as we have now entered into the Easter Season.


The Easter Season runs for a longer period of time than Lent. Lent is 40 days (from Ash Wednesday to Easter). The Easter Season is 50 days, from Easter to Pentecost. Easter Time is a season of mystagogy. It is the season in which the Church returns again and again to the central experience of the Paschal Mystery that has been celebrated again in the Triduum. Our attention is so closely focused on this story (the Paschal Mystery), that it sometimes seems that we are hearing the same readings over and over at Mass. But this is where the blessing and the opportunity comes in.

As believers, we are encouraged and spiritually motivated by the events of the Paschal Mystery. They hearken back to the

eternal truth which is Jesus Christ crucified and risen. This shows us the Father's great love and mercy for His people. This is an opportunity for growth. The blessing comes in the outreach of the Gospel message to the unbelievers or the "slack" in faith. A fresh springtime affords the opportunity to hear the familiar accounts and words yet again. True evangelization takes place in the human heart, and this is where the message of the Gospel will take its root and show its truth.

Easter Time can be a time of real growth for the Church, as she breaks open her own experience of the sacraments, of the Gospel, and of the Holy Spirit's work in the life of the church and its members. This work should also be a time to invite those who might have become disillusioned back into the contemplation of what it is that the Church celebrates. We are all given this time to learn to listen for God's action in our lives that can open the ears of our hearts, allowing us to see more clearly the actions of grace throughout our lives. God bless us all during this special time!

Give thanks to the Lord, for his is good, his love is everlasting. (Ps 118)



Divine Mercy Sunday

Thirty years ago my cousin Patty, the purest soul I've ever known, was on her way to Marianne Williamson's class A Course in Miracles in the Bay Area. Stepping off the bus, she was approached by an armed assailant. Doing as she'd been trained to do while living in a dangerous city in dangerous times, she dropped her purse and ran for her life. He shot her in the back anyway. Risen One, where was your MERCY then?

Three weeks ago another young man suffering from mental illness, armed to the teeth with combat weapons he bought legally, murdered ten beautiful humans in a grocery store. Risen One, where was your MERCY then?

Here in Colorado, of course, we've won the Triple Crown. We can't go to high school, the movies, or the grocery store. Young men suffering from mental illness, but cogent enough to plant bombs and hide assault weapons, have stripped us of the slightest veneer of safety we may feel for ourselves or for those we love. O Risen One, where is your MERCY now?

Well, the MERCY is here with us, holding out his pierced wrists and exposing his punctured side. Here, he says to us, touch my wounds. Feel my agony. Now hold out your hands and let me touch yours.

Okay. I'll take that invitation. Here, Jesus. Feel my wounds. I can't look at those darling young faces, those dear older faces, and please, please don't make me hear one single thing about the people who love them.


He touches my wounds, and holds my bleeding hands, and my broken heart. We both weep. That's where the MERCY is now.


