Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

CICADAS EVERYWHERE!

Last week, I had the opportunity to travel to Washington DC for a few days to attend my niece, Grace's High School Graduation. My brother and sister-in-law live in Northern Virginia, which in June of 2021 seems to be "Cicada Central"! Are you familiar with these lovely little creatures? They are a flying insect which comes out (swarms) of the ground in very large numbers every 17 years. They are present in some number every year, but that 17th year is one to remember. Well, 2021 is year 17.

Cicadas come out of the ground and burrow upward. They fly around a while, climb trees, and shed an exo-skeleton which litters the landscape everywhere around. They have red eyes, and lacy, almost delicate wings. They seemingly serve no earthly purpose, other than to provide food for birds, cats, foxes and other animals. I was told that most dogs get sick when eating a cicada, so they do not indulge. This is one of the questions to put on your list to ask God about when you get to heaven, Cicadas, why?

During the interminable loud racket they make; in fact being constant during the heat of the day, I was reflecting on other cicadas in our life. In fact, our lives can be full of them. The

media, our phones, traffic, the constant hubbub of life intrudes on us in ways we sometimes ignore. Just like the cicadas, we become a bit "immune" to the noise. However, for our spiritual lives, this cannot be a benefit. Prayer and quiet meditative time has to be sought out very often in our busy-ness. It does not fall into our laps. Prayer is a meeting with God. God meet us, and we meet God. St. John Henry Newman once said that prayer is "heart speaking to heart". For this truth to be most effective, the heart has to be able to hear!

I would encourage you to find that quiet opportunity, time and place to be with God in prayer. Many people I talk with wish for more, fruitful prayer time. This is a task worth undertaking. Prayer is always beneficial to all involved, including those being prayed for. Also, that small "community" of prayer (God and us) has such an impact on the larger community (the church of God). Cicadas, or their like, will always be around. Every 17 years, they will become overwhelming! However, time with God is blessed indeed, and so essential for our souls where the true glory of God dwells.

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

This weekend, as I read about the shoot taken from the mighty cedar and planted on the mountain heights of Israel, I find myself thinking about the historic north Denver church where my husband Ben leads the choir on Sundays.

If you were baptized in Denver between 1907 and 1940, there's a thirty percent chance you were baptized at Annunciation Parish. The Irish, Italians, and Germans built the church, and filled its grade school and high school. Those were the glory years, when the immigrant Church packed the pews, and the mighty shoot of deep religious faith was planted in Denver, 5280 feet up above sea level.

Later, devout African Americans put down roots in the parish, and today a robust Hispanic community fills the Church. The neighborhood is changing again, and the young, upwardly mobile Anglos walking by the church are starting to be lured into stepping inside.

Imagine this: there is one singer in this tiny eight-person choir who has sung in the choir since the late seventies. For over forty years, Ron Vigil has set his alarm, dressed, and arrived to sing for Mass.


For many years, under the leadership of the Sisters of Charity of Leavenworth, the choir was massive, and music soared to the heights of the Gothic ceiling. In the late eighties, in fact, Hollywood came calling, and filmed many episodes of The Father Dowling Mysteries there. Ron can pull up the episodes that featured the choir and play it for you, if you'd like.

Faith can take root from the mightiest tree, or the tiniest mustard seed. The task, though, is to stay faithful. How else can later generations find shade beneath your branches?

This also includes a reforestation project that involves planting two million trees to help the co-op achieve a zero carbon footprint.
