## Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

### YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH

The Church is celebrating the Year of St. Joseph in 2021. This comes in the 150th anniversary year of the Proclamation of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church in 1871. This was proclaimed by Pope Pius IX. Pope Francis felt this was especially meaningful during this pandemic year. In his proclamation, he writes, "My desire to do so increased during these months of pandemic, when we experienced, amid the crisis, how our lives are woven together and sustained by ordinary people, people often overlooked. Each of us can discover in Joseph—the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence—an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble. St. Joseph reminds us that those who appear hidden or in the shadows can play an incomparable role in the history of salvation."

St. Joseph answered "yes" to God's call, just as his spouse Mary did with her "Annunciation". Joseph's response was carried out in his role as Jesus' protector, teacher, and guide. He cared for the Son of God with a fatherly affection. Just as Jesus entrusted the Church to his mother, and our response is to acknowledge her as Mother of the Church, so Joseph's role

remains one of protector of the Church of God. Fathers are not born, but made. A man does not become a father simply by bringing a child into the world, but by taking up the responsibility to care for that child. Whenever a man accepts responsibility for the life of another, in some way he becomes a father to that person. In this, we see that St. Joseph is our universal father and protector and patron.

Here at Spirit of Christ, we are marking this year, by commemorating that special place of St. Joseph in our church. We are introducing a statue of St. Joseph into our church. It is by the same artist as the designer of the St. Mary statue. It will be placed in a position of honor near the Baptismal Font, for us all to honor as we enter the church.

If you would like to contribute to the statue of St. Joseph, for yourself or in memory of a loved one, we would be happy to receive your donations. Please contact the Parish Office if you are interested in this legacy. St. Joseph continues to protect and teach the Church of God. We are grateful for his patronage, this year and throughout our lives.

### Pope to grant Plenary Indulgences on the First World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly to be celebrated July 25, 2021.

The theme is "I am with you always." The Pope has granted the establishment of the World Day that will be observed every year on the fourth Sunday of the month of July. On the occasion of the First World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly, Pope Francis grants Plenary Indulgences to grandparents, the elderly and all the faithful who participate "motivated by a true spirit of penance and charity."

The Plenary Indulgence will be granted under the usual conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Pope. This Court of Mercy also grants the Plenary Indulgence on this same day to the faithful who devote adequate time to actually or virtually visiting their elderly brothers and sisters in need or in difficulty (such as the sick, the abandoned, the disabled and other similar cases),"



### Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The assault of Nebuchadnezzar's army on the citizens of Jerusalem in 597 BC is, until the Holocaust, certainly the greatest horror ever afflicted upon the Jewish people. A third of the population died by fire, a third by the sword, and a third were taken away in chains, to be marched 1700 miles to Babylon.

Jeremiah, who had the terrible burden of witnessing this seige, must certainly have thought, "how did this happen?" and "who didn't do their job along the way, that this could happen to us now?" His answer was bitter: it was the religious and civil leadership of Jerusalem that failed us, for years and years. Woe to those shepherds.

Watching the videos of the collapse of the condominium complex in Florida, and trying to imagine how this could possibly have happened, we feel like Jeremiah. Whose fault is this? How did an event like this happen in our own rich country? We've heard the answers, but no matter how we try to distance ourselves, a deep disturbance is rising within us. Something is very wrong.

Every city in our wealthy country is now faced with encampments on the street and in neighborhoods. How did we lose our way? How can we recover the bright hope of decades past?

Jesus gets this. He's trying to help his travel-weary disciples get some rest from the crowds surging around them, but the people simply run ahead to meet them. Jesus understands that something has gone terribly wrong. The basic needs of the people have not been met.


Understanding that HE is their most basic need, he takes the time to teach them many things. Finally, something has gone terribly right.
