## Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

### WHAT ARE THE "LAST RITES"?

When a Catholic is very ill, facing upcoming surgery, or perhaps near death; the priest will very often be called in to administer "Last Rites". The terminology may or may not be correct depending on the situation. Last Rites or officially, "The Last Rites of the Church" are a series of three Sacraments given and received at the same time. These are the "rites". They are usually administered just prior to death. Those Sacraments are: Reconciliation, Eucharist and the Anointing of the Sick. In actual practice, the giving of the Last Rites is very uncommon. I have administered it probably several dozen times in my 30 year priesthood.

Very often, near the time of death, the person is not lucid, unable to take nourishment or liquid, comatose and generally unable to communicate. This makes the actual practice of a "confession" very unlikely. And, very often, the patient cannot receive the Eucharist because they are unable or not allowed to consume anything by mouth. The vast majority of the time what is offered at this moment of one's life (and near death) is the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. In older times, it was referred to as "Extreme Unction". In this Sacrament, the patient is strengthened spiritually, emotionally, and physically by God's grace. They are made aware that the people of God, the body of the Church, is walking with them in prayer. Many who receive this Sacrament experience great conso-

lation and support. This can also extend to the person's support system, family, and caregivers.

My advice to all is that if death seems imminent, please contact the parish or a priest. If the Last Rites are an option (and possible, they can be administered. But, the best option may be the Anointing of the Sick. This Sacrament can also be administered at any time. If you know of upcoming surgery, do not hesitate to ask for the Sacrament prior to entry into the hospital. The spiritual grace of the Sacrament will assist you in your hospital stay.

It is so very important for our fellow parishioners and family members to feel the grace and power of God when they most need it, in the time of illness or when death is imminent. The Church offers the beautiful Sacrament of Anointing, or the Last Rites when possible. Also, be mindful of hospital protocols. Due to HIPPA privacy laws, most hospitals will have you designate when you enter a hospital whether or not you wish to have "chaplain services". If you do not check the box, you probably will not be visited by a hospital chaplain during your stay. However, most chaplain services in a hospital will assist you in getting in touch with your home parish or another priest if the need arises. As we are ever mindful of God's gracious mercy, we thank God for his many gifts, not least the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

#### Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Catholic Church has a “tell. That’s a gambling term that means a soft spot, a giveaway. No matter how much of a “poker face” the player maintains, there will be something---a lowering of the eyes, a slight smirk, a twitch of an eyebrow---that telegraphs oh boy, have I got a great hand.

The Catholic Church has a “tell,” and we don’t even try to hide it. We will talk about the Eucharist every single chance we get. We love it, we need it, we celebrate it every single day of the year. (Well, we were SUPPOSED to fast from the Eucharist on Good Friday, but that didn’t last too long before the rites included bringing the reserved Eucharist from Holy Thursday to believers for reception.)

Catholics simply will not be without the Eucharist, even when there is no Mass, as on Good Friday. I love the way Fr. Terrance Klein explained the reception of Communion on that day. When speaking of the ONE DAY that is the GREAT THREE DAYS of the Easter Triduum, he said: We pause in time. Christ does not. Christ carries all of time within himself.

Enter Mark’s gospel. At sixteen chapters, it’s by far the shortest of the four gospels. Sure, there could have been enough to lovingly linger over through the 34 weeks of Ordinary Time, but hey! Here’s an idea! When we cycle into Mark’s (short) gospel every three years, let’s break in for a five-week reflection on the EUCHARIST in the summer!

What a good idea! So we now segue over to John’s gorgeous Bread of Life discourse for the next five weeks. Why? Because boy have we got a good hand.

Do you know where your First Communion picture is? This is a good month to display it.
