Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

GET TO KNOW G.K. CHESTERTON

Who is Gilbert Keith Chesterton? If you are a listener of Catholic Radio, you will occasionally hear the "Chesterton" minute; short snippets of thought and wit from this most interesting Catholic writer and philosopher. Chesterton was born in London in 1874 to non-practicing Unitarians. Though baptized into the Anglican church, he did not practice the faith until his marriage. Eventually at the age of 48, he converted to Catholicism. He worked as a journalist, serving as the art and literary critic for the London Daily News. He eventually would write 80 books, several hundred poems, 200 short stories, 4,000 essays, and several plays. A writer of several romance novels, he is most famous for the Father Brown series of short stories, with its crime-solving priest. These are a staple of PBS television. He even wrote several hymns. One, "O God of Earth and Altar" was paraphrased in the Iron Maiden (yes Iron Maiden) song, "Revelations"!

His influence came mostly in his writings on the faith and particularly Catholicism. His two great works, "Orthodoxy", and "The Everlasting Man" are masterworks of modern apologetics. Fulton Sheen said that "the greatest influence in writing was G.K. Chesterton who never used a useless word, who saw the value of a paradox, and avoided what was trite". His writings consistently displayed wit and a sense of humor. He employed paradox, while making serious comments on the

world, government, politics, philosophy and theology. Here is an example, "The whole modern world has divided itself into Conservatives and Progressives. The business of Progressives is to go on making mistakes. The business of the Conservatives is to prevent the mistakes from being corrected."

He spoke out against Hitlerism in Germany very early and very firmly. He also opposed eugenics, the rise of industrialism as it impacted the values of the family, and the unjust treatment of the poor and uneducated. Chesterton's contribution to philosophy lies in what has come to be called, "Chesterton's fence". It is the principle that reforms should not be made until the reasoning behind the existing state of affairs is understood.

Chesterton has proven to be timeless. His writings and thought still speak in a contemporary way to modern society. His works of theology are inspired, and reflect the depth of his own faith and the impact of his conversion to Christ in the Catholic faith. A large man, six foot four and nearly 300 pounds, he died of congestive heart failure in 1936, at the age of 62. His funeral was held in Westminster Cathedral. Near the end of his life, Pope Pius XI awarded him the Star of the Papal Order of St. Gregory the Great. His cause has also been introduced for canonization. As T.S. Eliot, a close friend, stated, "He was importantly and consistently on the side of the angels". Get to know this great writer and defender of the Catholic faith

Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

I take such strength from Peter. He got it right about half the time. But he got it REALLY RIGHT at the beginning of today's gospel, when he confessed Jesus as the Christ, the Messiah. And then, just a few verses later, he admonished Jesus that OF COURSE he wouldn't suffer and die. That's not how Messiahs work!

And just like that he was back at the end of the line, "getting behind" Jesus instead of walking with him in the front. Like so many who encountered Jesus in Mark's gospel, Peter took his place with the others who were following Jesus on the Way.

When Jesus announced that those who followed him would have crosses as well, I would have headed for the hills. Nobody told me that the price of admission to the kingdom involves suffering! Where is the escape clause in this contract?

Way back when we were baptized, we (or our parents and God-parents), renounced Satan and all his empty promises. And one of those empty promises, probably the most seductive of all, is that there are ways to get through life without suffering.

Turn these stones to bread! Satan tempted a hungry Jesus. Throw yourself down from the Temple parapet and let the angels catch you! a mocking Satan invited Jesus to break the laws of nature.


God bless St. Peter. He was confused, and afraid. But still he followed Jesus. Years later, utterly joyous to meet his Risen Lord, he invited his executioners to crucify him upside down. He felt unworthy to die in the same posture as his Christ. And he knew that the gates of heaven were reaching down to receive him.


