

Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

THE ROLE OF CONSCIENCE

Conscience is a word very much in the news today. In the past, we often read and heard of "conscientious" objectors, those who for personal or religious reasons did not want to participate in war or military action. Today, the papers are rife with "religious conscience" mostly with regard to the reception or non-reception of the COVID vaccine. But, just what is the essence of conscience and what role does it play in our Catholic moral life?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church is the best reference for us in this area. Paragraph 1777 explains it well, "Moral conscience, present at the heart of the person, enjoins him at the appropriate moment to do good and to avoid evil. It also judges particular choices, approving those that are good and denouncing those that are evil." This definition teaches us two things, first, that conscience is "placed" within us by God. It is aligned with our God-given soul, and second, it is the basis of our decision-making, for the good and against the evil.

It is necessary for conscience to be formed, otherwise it is just "opinion", "emotion", or "feelings". These are not a part of conscience formation. Christians are called to "form" their consciences. As Catholics, we gain this from Scripture (especially the teachings and guidance of Jesus), and the teachings of the Church, which are reflective of Divine Revelation. As the Catechism states, "Conscience formulates its judgments according to reason, in conformity with the

true good willed by the wisdom of the Creator." (#1783). Conscience must be aligned to something greater than our simple passions. There are pitfalls in consequence. The Catechism again states, "The education of conscience is indispensable for human beings who are subjected to negative influences and tempted by sin to prefer their own judgment and to reject authoritative teachings." (#1783). A human being must always obey the certain judgment of his conscience. However, it can happen that moral conscience remains in ignorance and makes erroneous judgments. Think of the conscience as a light in the darkness. The Word of God is a light for our path. We must work to assimilate it in faith and prayer and put it into practice. This is how moral conscience is formed. A life-long task for us all.



Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Don't you wonder what Blind Bartimaeus saw when Jesus opened his eyes? I remember my own experiences of having those eye drops that dilate the pupils during exams. It's always a very weird hour or so while the eyes that have served me so well my whole lifetime shift back into shape.

As far as we know, Bartimaeus didn't have a lifetime of seeing, of making sense of images. It takes quite a while for a newly-sighted person to learn how to interpret all the visual data flooding the brain. But-- and I love this--it appears that the first image he saw was the face of Jesus! And that, friends, took no trial and error, no unscrambling of visual cues at all. He saw Jesus, and left everything to follow him on the Way.

It's that moment of clarity that touches me. I've had several of those moments in my life, where I've seen Jesus more clearly. I always, always see him in the sacraments, of course. As I reflect back, I've also seen him in conversation. Sometimes I'll have a stunning moment of clarity while talking with a beloved friend or family member.

All of a sudden, I sense the unmistakable presence of Jesus, healing and giving grace to my friend, and to me. Other times, I glimpse him in the challenges so many people meet every day as they embrace difficult children, difficult work situations, difficult health failings. Look!, I think, take courage! The Master is calling you! Tell him what you want him to do for you.


In fact, I'll bet he's calling you right now. Open your eyes and tell him what you need.

Migrant Ministry's Sharing About Day of the Dead, Last week, the information explained the history of the holiday. This week the information is about the modern day celebrations. Families gather to honor their ancestors with cleaning and decorating at the gravesites, sharing stories of the loved ones, singing, dancing, and special foods. Remembrance tables are decorated in a living area of the home. This table has personal items that belonged to the deceased family member and their favorite foods and drink. Every table represents a threshold between heaven and earth. The table has candles in order to light the way for the spirits and marigold flowers that give a pungent smell to guide the spirits toward earth. Everyone loves decorating sugar skulls "calaveras" and it is fun to write your own name on the skull in a bit of mockery toward death. The toys and artwork are skeletons going about everyday activities such as biking, playing in a musical band, getting married, chasing the dog or dressed-up in fine clothing. Pan de muerto is one of the specialty foods. The loaf of bread is in the shape of a skull decorated with white frosting in the shape of bones.




