

## Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

### ON CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME

Last week, our news was covering President Biden's trip to Glasgow, Scotland for a summit of world leaders on the issue of the environment. That being set aside, I would like to remind our faithful of the fact that the Church has spoken on this issue as well. In 2015, Pope Francis issued an encyclical entitled "Laudato Si", or "On Care for our Common Home". It addresses the call of stewardship of the earth. As we have just concluded our annual Stewardship "weekends", I trust that the Pope's words to the Church could help us understand a spiritual context of this important issue in everyone's life.

As the Pope says, "Human dignity rises out of the belief that we are created by God and found by Him to be good. We are made in God's image. Because we are created in love, we are capable of giving ourselves in love. Each human life is, therefore, valuable and unique. Each is held in God's hand. Scripture helps us see that human life is grounded in three close relationships: we relate to God, to our neighbor, and to the earth itself. By refusing to acknowledge that we humans have certain limits and that we are not the masters of the universe, we ruptured these relationships. We call this rupture by the name sin." (#65)

A misreading of Genesis 1:28 is to interpret God's mandate as humans exercising "dominion" over the earth, a stance that has no bounds and connotes a utilitarian relationship

with God's creation. A correct interpretation is "to exercise stewardship" over the earth, caring for it as the unique creation that it is, just like us. As the Pope states, "We humans, according to the Bible, must take our place within creation, not stand outside it in a superior position. It is a distorted view of human life that claims we are better or more important than the rest of creation. The Catechism teaches that each created animal or plant reflects the face of God." (#69).

Stewardship, and the true living of stewardship calls forth a great deal from us. However, this call is rooted in our hearts, and is formed by our unique relationship with God, who created us in love. As Pope Francis says, "We are all sisters and brothers to each other, bound together by an inner principle as children of one God. Such love leads us to forgive our enemies and live in peace. We must become convinced that we need each other. Being good and decent are what lead to happiness, and we must consider ourselves finished with the thin ethics that mocks honesty, faith, and communal concerns. In the spirit of St. Therese of Lisieux, we should let our daily habits be kind, peaceful, and self-giving." (#228). Such is the true nature of stewardship. Perhaps take the time to read Pope Francis' encyclical, "Laudato Si".



### Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

I am a fearful person. I've been too careful, too cautious. The world was certainly ending soon, and I wanted it to hurt as little as possible. Growing up, there were just enough prophets of doom around to keep me in a perpetual state of alarm. Some of their dire predictions have come true over time, but many have not. I confess that I chose fear over faith in every case.

It's been three spins around the sun since we heard Mark's terrifying apocalyptic account of the end times, but this time I'm noticing something that was there all along, waiting for me grab hold and reach safety.

It's this: right after Mark portrays the terrible tribulations--- stars falling from the sky, neither the sun nor moon giving any light---Jesus says, "Learn a lesson from the fig tree." What is the lesson that all fruit-bearing trees have for us?

Check it out, they say. Come in closer. See the leaves that fell last winter? They were stamped down into the earth by rain and snow. The tiny insects came and decomposed the leaves. Some of that was released into the atmosphere, and other parts remained and turned into nourishment for the soil. See those tiny buds? Uh huh. Apples. Peaches. Figs. Just you wait.

Just you wait, friends. Take a lesson from the fig tree. The Divine Plan is never that we should be paralyzed by fear. I get that now. It's embedded in the DNA of the trees. God intends to give us "a future and a hope" (Jer. 29:11).

Oh, and here's some other good news. The joy-filled Gospel of Luke is right around the corner.

How has a fearful heart stopped you from embracing a life of faith?




