Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

OUR HOLY FAMILY

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. It commemorates that true "Holy" Family of Mary, Joseph and Jesus. It is a very fitting and timely feast coming right on the heels of the Birth of Christ at Christmas. These beautiful feast of the Church help us not only to reflect and focus upon the things above, but also look to our own human attempts to be a holy family in our own lives and world. Family is a word which can conjure up a great variety of responses and feelings. To some, it is a true haven, a place of nurturing and care and concern. For some, it can be a painful memory, when family has been less than ideal or even absent. But, we are privileged to share with our Holy Family at this time.

Both the Second Vatican Council and the Catechism of the Catholic Church dedicate sections of their teaching to the nature, purpose and status of our own human families. The Catechism gives us a beautiful definition, "The Christian family constitutes a specific revelation and realization of ecclesial communion, and for this reason it can and should be called a 'domestic church" (C.C.c. #2204). The family is a true church, situated in the home. It is where (ideally) a child first learns of the ways of faith, the love of God, prayers, and the moral life.

The Christian family has an evangelizing and missionary task. As the Catechism states, "In the procreation and

education of children it reflects the Father's work of creation. It is called to partake of the prayer and sacrifice of Christ. Daily prayer and the reading of the Word of God strengthen it in charity" (C.C.C. #2205). Years ago, the television series Murphy Brown entered into a controversy when Murphy herself had a child out of wedlock. It opened a nation-wide debate of what was exactly a "family"? I believe that our definition horizon has broadened somewhat. A family is seen as a group of individuals who support, nourish, help guide, and love each other. This is what society today holds and this is what the Church has long taught.

Of course, the biological unity is the most basic and fundamental of family units. If it remains true to the Holy Family, it can bear great fruit for its members and society. Per the Catechism, "Authority, stability, and a life of relationships within the family constitute the foundations for freedom, security and fraternity within society" (C.C.C. #2207). Because of its essential nature with regard to our society, it is necessary for it to be supported by appropriate social measures. This extends as well to support for marriage, children, the unborn and the single life. During this holy season especially, let us all pray for the strengthening in love and security for all the family to which we belong. God bless us all during this season of joy and hope.

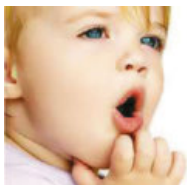

Christmas Day and Feast of the Holy Family

I hear those angels sometimes, because I know they're hanging out in my neighborhood too. I hear them bursting into Glorias whenever anyone does anything to help bring peace on earth. When, as the Eucharistic Prayer of Reconciliation says so beautifully, "enemies begin to speak to one another, and those who were estranged join hands in friendship," I think I hear them, shouting Glorias in the highest.

Here's an easy way to hear them, and this is the perfect season. Lay down your estrangements, and your righteous certitudes. Let peace flow like a river. Now that your heart is wide open, unstop your ears and listen. Ah, yes. Glora in excelsis Deo!

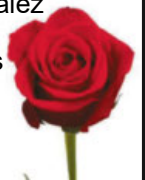

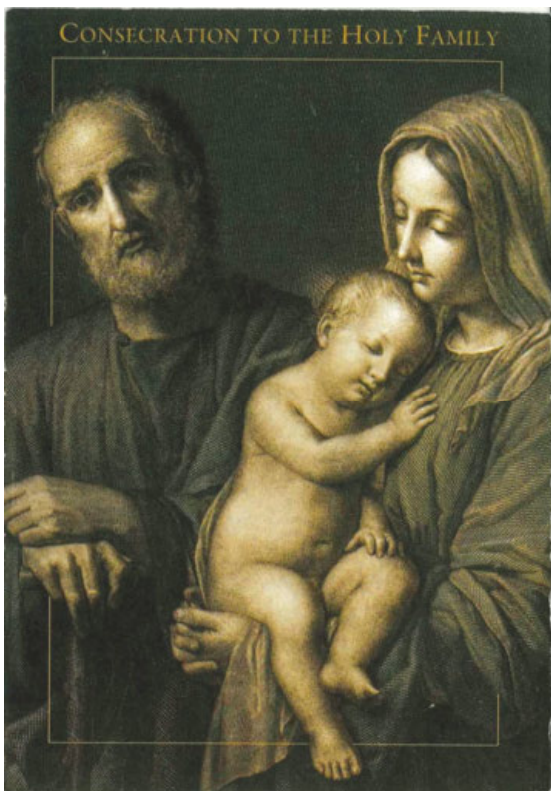

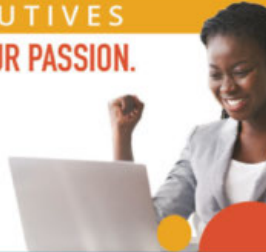
