Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

THE FEAST OF EPIPHANY

This weekend, we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. "Epiphany" is a word which means "manifestation" or "appearing". It speaks of Christ's manifestation to the world. The Magi arrive from the East to worship the newborn King. These travelers, pagan Gentiles are representative of the world, just as the shepherds on Christmas evening have represented the Jewish people. In this way, Christ is revealed as the Prince of Peace, King of the Nations, True Messiah.

This feast is celebrated on a par with Christmas throughout the Eastern Church, and in the Middle East. This is traditionally the day of "gift exchange" in most European countries. Think of the song, "The Twelve Days of Christmas". From the beginnings of the Church, this day has been seen as the fullness of God's theophany, God revealing Himself to us and to the world. Church Fathers have written of this momentous day.

St. Augustine says, "Only a few days ago we celebrated the Lord's birthday. Today we are celebrating with equal solemnity, as is proper, his Epiphany, in which he began to manifest himself to the Gentiles. On the one day the Jewish shepherds saw him when he was born; on this day the magi coming from the east adored him. Now, he had been born that cornerstone, the peace of the two walls coming

from very different directions, from circumcision and uncircumcision. Thus they could be united in him who had been our peace, and "who has made both one." This was foretold in the Jewish shepherds and the Gentile magi. From this began what was to grow and to bear fruit throughout the world. Let us therefore, with joy of the spirit hold dear these two days, the Nativity and the Manifestation of our Lord. The Jewish shepherds were led by an angel bringing the news; the Gentile magi by a star showing the way." On the 4th Sunday of Advent, the prophet Micah spoke in the First Reading, "He will be peace". On this Epiphany and at the beginning of this new year of grace, let us all pray for that peace, which Christ brings, to take root in the hearts of all humanity, across cultures, religions, and generations. Christ is the true bearer of peace, but we take on our own disciple role in manifesting peace into our own world. Pope St. Leo the Great shares his prayer from the 5th century, "The gifts of God are multiplied, and we in our time experience all that the first believers did. For though the gospel account tells us only of the days when three men, untaught by prophetic preaching or the testimonies of the Law, came from the distant East in order to know God, yet we see the same thing happening now even more clearly and on a far larger scale in the enlightenment of all who are called."

Lord, every nation on earth will adore you. (Ps 72)

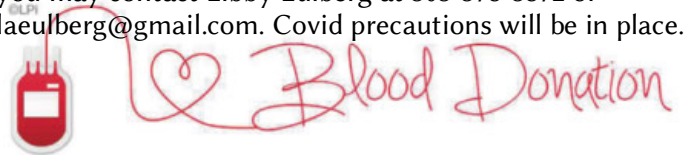
Gifts of the Spirit

Epiphany of the Lord

Wouldn't you love to know more about those mysterious Magi, who left everything to follow a Star from the day of its rising? They fascinate me. There are innumerable legends about them, including their names Balthazar (of Arabia), Melchior (of Persia), and Caspar (of India). One of the more charming legends is that in the ancient silk road city of Taxila (in present-day Punjab, Pakistan), one of the Magi passed through the city on the way to Bethlehem.

Later Christian writings identified them as kings, certainly because the Old Testament scriptures bear many prophecies of royalty. Today's first reading from Isaiah 60:1-6 refers to "kings coming to the brightness of your dawn," and the Responsorial Psalm sings of "all kings falling down before him" (72:11). It made perfect sense to imagine that these very wise men must have been the royalty the Old Testament writers were awaiting. Maybe they were.

Here's what fascinates me. These Gentiles saw a bright star rising, and they left everything to follow it. When it hovered over Jerusalem they stopped and announced themselves as ones who had come to give homage to the newborn King of the Jews. Isn't that astounding? They were willing to leave their pre-Christian worldviews in search of a Jewish King. Why?

I think it's because that's how God touches all of us. God recruits all of nature to tell the glory of God. The winter chill, the spring rains, the abundant summer fruits, the stunning autumns, all speak to a God who is with us. I think the Magi were just fascinated, as we are, by the heavens touching down to earth, and saying, "Here. Here. Come and worship."
