#### **OUR ROLE IN THE UPCOMING SYNOD**

As has been mentioned in this space, Pope Francis has called for a universal "synod" of the entire church. The process will extend from 2021 to 2023. Each Diocese is coordinating efforts within their jurisdiction for this great event. Here in Denver, the Denver Archdiocesan-wide Discernment Event will take place from March 25-27. Prior to this, each parish will hold its own listening sessions. This is truly a once in a lifetime moment for us, a generational opportunity to listen to God and his plan for the Archdiocese of Denver in this apostolic age.

Spirit of Christ will host 4 listening session/gatherings to which anyone and everyone is invited. These will be held on January 27, February 3, February 10, and February 17. Each session will begin at 6:30pm. A synod is intent on listening, listening to the call of the Holy Spirit in the lives of the faithful. Wisdom and discernment is necessary to truly allow the Spirit's call to be heard and taken to heart, and if need be, put into action. The sessions will focus on the following three areas: MISSION OF THE CHURCH: What do you hear the Holy Spirit saying in prayer to the Church of Northern Colorado on how He wants that mission to be carried out in our apostolic time? MISSION OF THE PARISH: What do you hear the Holy Spirit saying in prayer to the church of Denver about how our parishes can more effectively live out that mission? and MISSION OF THE DISCIPLE: What do you hear the Holy Spirit saying

to you personally, in prayer, about how you are called to live out that mission today?

You may start thinking and praying about these questions in advance. Be prepared to attend one of the Synod "Listening Sessions" and share your reflection and insights. This is truly a time for us all to invest in our Church, and to invest in a timeless process which has been a form of consultation and discernment in the Church since apostolic times. Pope Francis, in the preparatory document for this Synod has expressed that it is based on the principles of "Communion", "Participation", and "Mission". Let's all do our small part in the larger Church to let Christ and His Gospel of Good News be known in the world.



#### **Third Sunday in Ordinary Time**

My husband Ben returned from a recent trip to Juarez, Mexico with a beautiful painting of Joseph and the Child Jesus. We put it up against the wall, and soon Christmas cards surrounded it on all sides. It was touching to see the art on the cards, celebrating the birth of Jesus, and this lovely painting in the center. It's kind of an old-fashioned painting, but here's what I noticed: I like looking at it. It makes me happy.

It's probably not great art. I've decided I don't care. In fact, just yesterday, as we finally took away all the cards, we chose to make the painting a permanent fixture on the wall.

I've loved the image of the Child Jesus since we visited Ávila, Spain a few years ago, and heard this touching story about St. Teresa. One night, Teresa was walking the grounds of the monastery when she saw a beautiful child. "Who are you?" he asked. "I'm Teresa of the Child Jesus. Who are you?" And He answered, "I am the Child Jesus of Teresa."

Even today, the tears come. We are "of him," and he is "of us." And so, today, when I read about six thousand members who serve more than 75,000 children living in poverty---the demographic nearest my heart---I was touched at the name of the organization: The National Christ Child Society. I signed up.

See, I think that's how the gifts Paul speaks about become actualized. An image on the wall, a touching story from my adult life, and the exact ministry I've been looking for, all with The Child Jesus in the title. That's how the Spirit speaks. That's how the Body works.
