

pastor's note



When Christ sent out the apostles to bring the Good News to the world, it thankfully didn't take long for them to need help. Through the sacrament of Holy Orders, they would share the apostolic ministry with many more bishops, priests and deacons. Today the Catholic Church has about 5,600 bishops, 414,000 priests, 49,000 deacons and 1.2 billion faithful.

It is the duty of a bishop, as a successor to the apostles, to be the pastor of everyone in the territory of his diocese; to carry out the functions of teaching, sanctifying and governing. The Archdiocese of Denver spans 25 counties, operates 149 locations where a stable Sunday Mass is celebrated and has about 600,000 baptized Catholics. The entire Archdiocese is one local church but we know that it is not humanly possible for the Archbishop to pastor such a vast enterprise. Thus, he has delegated his pastoral ministry to 108 priests who serve as pastors of parishes.

This Sunday, Archbishop Aquila will celebrate our 10:30AM Mass and he and I will perform the ceremonial rites of my installation as pastor. While we are just one of the 149 locations, we all know that we are one of the largest and the most complex parishes in the Archdiocese. I am at the same time excited, humbled and nervous to take on such a mantle.

In the Code of Canon Law (the universal set of laws which governs the entire Catholic Church), it says:

Whenever it is necessary or opportune in order to carry out the pastoral care of a parish fittingly, one or more parochial vicars can be associated with the pastor. As coworkers with the pastor and sharers in his solicitude, they are to offer service in the pastoral ministry by common counsel and effort with the pastor and under his authority. (CAN. 545 §1.)

While it is my desire to be present to the parish as much as possible, the archbishop has asked that I split my time between the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center and our parish. Understanding the expansive pastoral work that exists here at St. Thomas More, the archbishop has assigned four parochial vicars, or assistant priests, to help in Christ's mission: Fathers Chris, Ivan, Matt and Rohan. I am grateful for their assistance.

As a parish, we are going to go through a time of transition. Msgr. Fryar is a great priest and I know you all will miss him. So, may I ask your prayers for the following intentions?

- Please pray for me and for the four vicars that we will have a holy fraternity among us that will enable us to be excellent in our ministry.
- Pray for the staff that they be given the graces to continue to serve the people of God in charity and fellowship and that they will have patience with me
- Pray for the entire parish to have patience and graciousness with me and with one another as we progress through this transition, and that we may be a city on a hill, i.e., a beacon of hope amid the darkness that we find in these challenging times in which we have been called to live out our mission as disciples.



a reflection on today's readings

Grow as a Disciple

My favorite line in "The Wizard of Oz," in the climactic scene when Dorothy realizes "there's no place like home," comes from Glinda, "You've always had the power to go back to Kansas," she tells Dorothy. In the first reading today, Moses tells the Israelites something similar about wisdom and power. He tells them the secret to peace and prosperity isn't "mysterious" or "remote." He says "it is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts." In the Gospel, when the scholar asks Jesus about the secret to eternal life, he answers his own question by reciting the two great commandments: love God with all your heart, being, strength and mind, and your neighbor as yourself. "You have answered correctly," Jesus tells him. At our baptism, the Holy Spirit placed the wisdom and power to have the fullness of life in our hearts. The key is to "carry it out," as Moses advises the Israelites. Jesus echoes this message: We must "do this" love God and our neighbor—to enjoy the life God wants for us today and eternal life with Him in the future.

Go Evangelize

One of the most heartbreaking things about being a parent is seeing children set limits for who's in and who's out. My daughter was in Kindergarten when she came home in tears excluded from playing with her friends because she didn't color a picture exactly as directed by another classmate. Our loving Father also sees our pain when we are excluded from being loved, and so when the scholar asks Jesus, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus refuses to set boundaries for who to include and who to exclude. In using the parable about the Samaritan, Jesus tells us that we are to treat everyone as neighbor, even our enemies. The Samaritans were enemies of the Jews and those listening to Jesus would have been shocked that a Samaritan was the compassionate hero. This parable challenges us to consider the boundaries we set for who we consider neighbors. Those worthy of our compassion and help and perhaps those we consider "other," or whom we feel we can ignore or reject. And to recognize how the boundaries we set prevent us from sharing the Good News of God's mercy to those He seeks to heal.

Pray

Ask the Holy Spirit for the wisdom to discern who you may be excluding as a neighbor. Pray these words from Dorothy Day: "Dear God, please enlarge our hearts to love each other, to love our neighbor, to love our enemy as well as our friend."
