pastor's note



Nine seconds. Scientists report that goldfish have a nine-second attention span. Unfortunately, they also report that humans have an eight-second attention span. I am not sure how these numbers were reached, but I think that the reality they reveal is problematic. We tend to spend less time being focused and more time being distracted.

We live in a world where everyone and everything is vying for our attention. An honest assessment of all these demands upon us would reveal that few of these things actually deserve our time and energy. The lie we tell ourselves is that multitasking is a virtue, e.g., texting and driving (don't do that). Out of necessity, we need some multitasking, but when it comes to the important relationships in our lives, what we really need is focus.

20th century philosopher Simone Weil once wrote, "Attention is the rarest and purest form of generosity." How wonderfully true and convicting this simple statement is. To grant someone our undivided attention seems like a big ask. To turn off the TV or computer, to silence a cell phone, to be in the presence of another for the sole purpose of being with them requires intentionality and purpose; it requires our generosity.

When I was a kid, TV trays and TV dinners were the evils that threatened the American family. Those things seem rather pedestrian by today's standards. The new cliché is an American family eating dinner with everyone looking at a devise of some sort. We might call this, eating together separately. On a larger scale, we can find ourselves living together separately. Life becomes a mindless routine of consuming short attention span entertainment while fulfilling meaningless tasks that provide for a meager existence void of flourishing.

We were created for relationships. When we live in isolation without authentic interaction, reciprocity and real love, we wither. This same issue extends to our relationship with God. While it is true that we can pray while doing other things like driving or folding laundry, abiding with God in intentional prayer is an activity that deserves our undivided attention. Fly by, crisis inspired or vending machine prayers do not foster a relationship with God that will lead to our thriving, to abundant life. Our relationships with God and with our family and close friends deserve the generosity of our attention.

In the gospel for this weekend, Martha's service provides the opportunity for her sister Mary to spend dedicated time paying attention to Jesus. Martha desires this time and, unfortunately, allows her service to sour and develop into envy; she is upset at the good her sister is enjoying. She ought to be happy that her service has cleared space in Mary's life to abide in relationship with Jesus. The healthy thing that we can anticipate in this family would be for Mary to do the chores the next time, so that Martha can have dedicated time with Jesus.

How might this translate into your lives, in your families? How can you be a non-bitter Martha providing time for prayer, or daily Mass, for others? How can you be a gracious Mary, willing to set aside focused time, away from the distractions of this world, to abide with the Lord?

a reflection on today's readings

Grow as a Disciple

Are you a Martha or a Mary? For me, it depends on the day but on first glance I'd say I relate more to Martha. When I plug in the vacuum and start handing out cleaning supplies, one of my sons invariably asks, "Is company coming over?" Even once they arrive, I'm often so busy with host duties that I don't really relax enough to truly connect with our guests! All of that said, I'm not sure Jesus is criticizing Martha or just talking about housework. Rather, He addresses her as a friend, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing." Mary, who sits at the feet of Jesus, shows us what matters most, our relationship with Jesus. It doesn't mean we won't get caught up in the busyness of entertaining or life in general. When that happens, however, Jesus' words can gently call us back to what matters most. The way we live our life for Christ each day and prioritizing our relationship with Him.

Go Evangelize

It's wedding season! I was recently talking to a friend whose daughter got married a few weeks ago. She and her daughter had spent months planning the wedding, of course, but the actual day went by "too fast," she said, her voice tinged with regret. Sometimes it seems life can be like that. We can get so caught up in the day-to-day that we forget to take a breath and savor each moment with friends and family. In today's readings, Mary shows us how to truly be present to Jesus by listening to His voice in prayer and reading His words in Scripture. Martha teaches us how to open our homes and our hearts through hospitality. We can learn from both of their examples, drawing strength from prayer and extending the peace of Jesus to others through hospitality and our everyday interactions.


