

pastor's note



"The sacrifice acceptable to God is a broken heart." In a letter (an epistle) attributed to St. Barnabas, the first century saint instructs believers to "carefully seek after our salvation" lest we be deceived by the devil and turn away from the path that leads to our salvation.

It seems like this

world has everything and nothing. Amazon will sell me everything from A to Z, but it cannot sell me a relationship with the one who is the Alpha and the Omega (the Greek A to Z), Jesus Christ. The world has an answer for all my "wants," but it lacks authentic solutions to my "needs." The world has formed me to seek riches in things like wealth, experiences, "likes" or number of views on social media, the square feet of my home, the car I drive, etc. Even if I could achieve all of these things and more, it would not make me rich in the eyes of God, in what matters to him. As a disciple, God wants to form my heart so that I am not seeking to accumulate goods, but rather, that I am seeking to become good, i.e., virtuous, or righteous by his standard.

What we need is not a heart that longs for everything the world offers, but rather a heart that is broken, a heart that is no longer in love with the world, a heart that is in love with God, seeking to leave behind the thinking of this world and to acquire the wisdom of God.

Many of these sentiments can be found in the Epistle

of St. Barnabas. While this letter is not considered scripture, like the writings of most saints, it serves as an aid to our own walk, our pilgrim's journey toward greater union with God.

A few years ago, I was inspired to take the content of Barnabas' letter and turn it into a prayer. In light of the readings for this weekend, and our real need to turn away from worldliness, I offer it to you here in my weekly column. The prayer has a border so that you can cut it out and put it somewhere that it can be used as a part of your prayer.

a reflection on today's readings

Grow as a Disciple

Is it me, or does every popular waiting-room magazine feature an article on "how to declutter" in six easy steps? I always read those first, then add them to the unsightly pile of magazines on the end table. The constant, if futile, quest to declutter comes from a deeper place than a desire for a clean house. It feels so liberating to let go of those things that we no longer need. Today's readings challenge us to look not just outward, but inward, at what distracts us from what really matters. Paul exhorts us to "seek what is above," letting go of earthly concerns or habits that get in the way of our relationship with God. By putting on a "new self" through prayer, the sacrament of reconciliation and receiving Jesus in the Eucharist we will become "rich in what matters to God."

Go Evangelize

Personal-finance writers often divide people into two camps, savers or spenders. I'm definitely a saver! I dutifully contribute to my 401K, stash unexpected windfalls into my savings account and carefully budget. On the rare occasions when I go out to dinner, I struggle with choosing what to order: It's a high-stakes decision! Fiscal responsibility is a good thing, but today's parable challenges me to be just as diligent about investing in my relationship with God, my family and the people I encounter. We are blessed with so many opportunities to "seek what is above." It may mean spending the first 30 minutes of the day in prayer, reading books or articles that help us grow spiritually, or joining a parish Bible study. Or even taking a friend to dinner and picking up the tab! In doing so, we are investing in this life — and the next.

Pray

Take a look around your house and donate items in good condition to a charity in your community. And then ask the organization if they need any help with a summer yard cleanup or simple tasks around the facility – these are easy ways to involve the whole family in serving others.
