

a reflection by Fr. Matt



Did you know that the first title given to someone on the path to canonization is "Servant of God?" Many might remember the question in the Baltimore Catechism, "Why did God make you?" Answer: "To know, love and serve him in this life and to be with him forever in heaven." What philosophers debate for centuries.

the Catholic Church teaches to children. When we believe in Jesus Christ as Lord, we offer our whole lives to him because he is good. We no longer see the goal of life as selfishness, i.e. to live only for ourselves. We want to give our hearts to the God we love, who loves us and live in a communion of heart and mind with him.

Servant of God Julia Greeley was born into slavery in Missouri and treated with such cruelty that her right eye was destroyed. When finally freed from that grave injustice in 1865, she worked for families in Missouri, New Mexico, Wyoming and Colorado. When she didn't have enough to help the poor, she would beg for food and clothing for the needy. She could be found at night, to avoid embarrassing poor families, pulling a red cart through the streets bringing them coal and groceries. One time she was even found carrying a mattress on her back to someone who needed it. Julia entered the Catholic Church at Sacred Heart Parish in Denver in 1880.

The one photo we have of Julia Greeley shows her holding someone's baby. She was working for a family and asked one day why they had no children. The woman responded that their son had died at eleven years of age from a

disease that prevented him from digesting food. The doctor said she would not be able to have more children. Julia responded, "I'm going to pray and you will see there will be a little girl running around here next year." And that is the baby in the photo.

What gave her strength? Julia loved the Blessed Sacrament and the Blessed Mother. She would go to Mass every day to be close to our Lord and receive him and his infinite love in the Holy Eucharist. She lived a life of prayer, allowing the Lord to be her light, her strength and joy.

To serve the Lord is to be caught up in a bigger adventure and plan than just "what will I wear today?" and "what will I eat?" It is to hear the call to communion with God, to abide in his infinite love and be a dwelling place for the King of kings. To hear the call to go and announce the Good News, inviting others to encounter the Savior of the world and find new life in him. To make an eternal difference in the lives of those around us by being witnesses to God's charity. And we know that our Lord Jesus lived out humble service and sacrificial love. "For the Son of man also came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" (Mk 10:45). While the motto of the devil might be "I will not serve" let ours be "I delight to do thy will, O my God; thy law is within my heart" (Ps 40:8).

And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me" (Is 6:8). Servant of God Julia Greeley pray for us!

a reflection on today's readings

Grow as a Disciple

I remember the first time I moved. A suitcase or two fit in the back of my dad's lime-green Delta 88 as my parents dropped me off at college. Four years later, it took that plus a large black chest. The next move required a U-Haul. Then came marriage, a family and a moving van. I may not store my treasure in barns like the man in last week's readings, but at times it feels that way. It's natural to accumulate more "stuff" as we grow older. But in today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that we won't take any of it with us when we make the move to our final destination. Rather than focus on our possessions, he encourages us to be vigilant, remain faithful and live in service to others. In doing so, we will store up "an inexhaustible treasure in heaven that no thief can reach nor moth destroy. For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."

Go Evangelize

Few things throw me into a panic like unexpected company. I have taken to at least cleaning the kitchen counter and bathrooms before going on a trip so the house will look presentable should something befall me and others have to come in with food or aid! We truly do not know the day or the hour, and the Gospel today encourages us to apply a little of that spring cleaning to our souls. Each day presents a new opportunity to prepare for the day we meet Jesus. If we've been out of touch, we can get reacquainted through prayer. If we feel weighed down by things we've done or said, we can bring them to the Lord through the sacrament of reconciliation. We can witness to our belief in God's promise of eternal life by putting people above possessions and supporting one another as we seek to live as Jesus taught us.

Today's psalm response is: "Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own." Count your blessings and write a few of them down, giving thanks to God for each of them.


