


## Vision 2030 Diocesan Pastoral Plan:

On September 14, 2020 Bishop Steven promulgated our diocesan pastoral plan. The theme of this plan is Communion for Mission: One Body in Christ, One Paschal Journey. The preparation process for this plan began in 2019 with the assistance of PartnersEdge. Every parish provided them extensive data. This data supplemented with demographic information accessible to PartnersEdge, produced a "current reality." This "current reality" became the starting point to envision the future of the Catholic community in Wyoming.

It is now time for us to enter the planning process. This planning process will bring to life at Holy Trinity, the values, vision, and goals expressed in Vision 2030. The planning process will begin with a meeting of parish staff and members of our Pastoral Council and Finance Council August 21<sup>st</sup>. A second meeting with Bishop Steven is scheduled for August 31<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 – 8:00 pm in Cabrini Hall. Bishop Steven will speak with us about Vision 2030: its theme, values and goals. 
As co-responsible members of this faith community, let us together pray for wisdom as we discern our mission in the context of Vision 2030.

Your child needs to be 3 or 4 by **August 1<sup>st</sup>** to enroll in our program. To enroll a child in kindergarten, they need to be 5 by **August 1<sup>st</sup>**. The new law was passed during the 2020 session of the Wyoming Legislature. St. Mary's School has tuition assistance available. ## Thoughts of the Pastor...

Amen is a word used frequently when we gather for liturgy. At our Sunday liturgies (Mass) we say amen to the Collect (Opening Prayer), conclusion of the Penitential Act, Prayer over the Offerings, conclusion of the Eucharistic Prayer, twice during the Communion Rite, Closing Prayer and the final blessing. That is a lot of amens! When we say "amen" what are we saying? As you might expect, the origin of the word is Hebrew, translated to Greek, Latin, and then English. In common usage it means: so it is, truly, or certainly. However, when used in our liturgies, there is a much more profound meaning. For example, when a minister of Communion says, "The Body of Christ," and we respond Amen, we are not simply affirming the truth proclaimed by the minister. In fact, we are offering a personal and communal commitment and surrender.

That means we give over our lives to be what we eat, the Body of Christ. The act of communion is more than consuming the Body and Blood of Christ. It is a decision and a choice to be an active, engaged member of the Body of Christ. This communion is certainly personal, but never private. It is a public act and proclamation. Our collective surrender to be Christ's Body lays claim to who we are and what we do. Jesus proclaimed in the Gospel today, "the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." Is not our amen at the time of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ a decision of surrender to be and do the same?

In the weeks ahead let us be attentive to when we say amen and may our amen be more than a simple affirmation of what is proclaimed.




## Everyday Stewardship

**What's Your Hearth Cake?:** "Get up and eat, or the journey will be too much for you." I've been to a lot of meetings in my years of work in the Church, and you can take my word for it: the ones with snacks just seem to go better.

I don't know what it is exactly. Maybe it's just that people are in a more agreeable mood if you show up with donuts. Or maybe it's about the very real sense of community and camaraderie that is created at a table where people are engaging in that most human of tasks — eating — beside one another. I think a big part of it comes down to the simple fact that we're all just nicer people when we're fed.

This rings true spiritually, too. We simply must remain fed if we, in turn, are to feed others. Think of a time when you have neglected your relationship with God — when you haven't fed yourself with whatever it is that you need to remain committed to the journey of a Christian life. Is it Mass attendance? Is it prayer or Scripture reading? Is it time with your small group, or conversation with a trusted friend who knows your soul? What sustains your ability to be a good disciple, a good steward? What inspires you to give more freely, to love more abundantly?

Whatever it is, that's your hearth cake. That's your jug of water. Don't neglect it. The Angel of the Lord is nudging you in your sleep: "Get up and eat, or the journey will be too much for you."






