


Vision 2030 Diocesan Pastoral Plan:

On September 14, 2020 Bishop Steven promulgated our diocesan pastoral plan. The theme of this plan is Communion for Mission: One Body in Christ, One Paschal Journey. The preparation process for this plan began in 2019 with the assistance of PartnersEdge. Every parish provided them extensive data. This data supplemented with demographic information accessible to PartnersEdge, produced a "current reality." This "current reality" became the starting point to envision the future of the Catholic community in Wyoming.

It is now time for us to enter the planning process. This planning process will bring to life at Holy Trinity, the values, vision, and goals expressed in Vision 2030. The planning process will begin with a meeting of parish staff and members of our Pastoral Council and Finance Council August 21st. A second meeting with Bishop Steven is scheduled for August 31st at 6:30 – 8:00 pm in Cabrini Hall. Bishop Steven will speak with us about Vision 2030: its theme, values and goals. Please join us for either or both meetings. A link to pertinent information can be found on the Diocese of Cheyenne website home page.

As co-responsible members of this faith community, let us together pray for wisdom as we discern our mission in the context of Vision 2030.

2021 – 2022 School Registration PK3 – 6th grade:

The school is now accepting registration for the 2021 - 2022 school year. We will have 3 year old and 4 year old programs again this year. Your child needs to be 3 or 4 by **August 1st** to enroll in our program. To enroll a child in kindergarten, they need to be 5 by **August 1st**. The new law was passed during the 2020 session of the Wyoming Legislature. St. Mary's School has tuition assistance available. Thoughts of the Pastor...

The bread of life discourse, contained in the sixth chapter of John's Gospel, concludes this weekend. We have listened to an intense dialogue between Jesus and the crowd. Some struggle with Jesus' claim to be bread from heaven, the new manna, sent by God. They respond, "Do we not know his father and mother? Then how can he say, 'I have come down from heaven'?" The crowd claims to know him, but only partially. As a result, their hearts grow hardened by their decision to refuse the revelation of Jesus' full identity. Even some disciples reply, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" As we heard today some chose to return to their former way of life. Jesus asks the twelve disciples, "Do you also want to leave?" Peter, representing the early community of disciples, makes a wonderful faith statement, "To whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." Did this proclamation of faith put to rest all the questions of the disciples? Of course not. But it served as the grounding of faith from which questions could be asked and explored.

Asking and exploring questions is a never ending reality for human beings. Faith and reason do work together as we investigate the richness and depth of our faith. As finite beings some answers will come more slowly while other answers will remain shrouded in mystery. Faith is what keeps us grounded through the varied challenges and moments in life. That is why formation in faith is a life-long journey. We cannot answer adult questions with answers learned in childhood. What are you doing to deepen your faith having been convinced that Jesus is the Holy One of God?



Everyday Stewardship

Submission as Stewardship: We aren't comfortable with the idea of submission. Our society champions equality, and rightly so — but it's a mistake to think that submission is at odds with equality. To submit ourselves fully, we must first be free. We must first be our own masters. God has granted us that freedom with the salvation He offers. We are no longer the slaves of sin. Now He asks us to be subordinate to one another, in the name of Christ.

What a completely uncomfortable task! What He's asking is for us to be subordinate to the person who irritates us the most. The person we really can't stand. The person who doesn't respect us or appreciate what we have to offer. The person we think we're smarter than, more talented than. The person we envy.

That's the real challenge of stewardship, isn't it? Subordination. Inconveniencing myself by giving of time, of money, of relationship. Putting the needs or wants of another above my own when they haven't done anything special to earn it.

I invite you to consider the cross — the most radical expression of submission, and of stewardship, that ever existed. If there was ever someone who deserved superiority, isn't it the God who let Himself be nailed to a tree, who gave so freely of His life, His body, His blood, His everything?

To look at him in his agony is to truly understand the beauty of submission — of laying down what you have for the good of the other.



Don't Miss the 2022 Oberammergau Passion Play!






