

### 2021 – 2022 School Registration PK3 – 6<sup>th</sup> grade:

The school is now accepting registration for the 2021 - 2022 school year. We have 3 year old and 4 year old programs again this year. Your child needs to be 3 or 4 by **August 1<sup>st</sup>** to enroll in our program. To enroll a child in kindergarten, they need to be 5 by **August 1<sup>st</sup>**. The new law was passed during the 2020 session of the Wyoming Legislature. St. Mary's School has tuition assistance available. Please call (638-9268) or stop by the school office and pick up a registration packet.

## Thoughts of the Pastor...

Recently, Bishop Steven led our community in a conversation regarding Vision 2030. It was a lively conversation that covered important topics such as the theme communion for mission, co-responsibility, and values to guide our efforts in pastoral planning.

The theme, communion for mission, reflects the reality of our baptism. Brought into the life of Christ as members of his Body, we intimately share in the mission of Christ. Our communion, originating in baptism, is affirmed each time we gather for Eucharist. At the end of every liturgy, we are told "go!" To be sent is to be missioned. Christ's mission is the salvation of all. We participate in this mission through proclaiming the Good News in word and action within our local community and beyond.

Because of our baptism we are co-responsible for communion and mission. It is not solely the task of clergy, religious, and parish staff. God has gifted every baptized member with particular gifts that foster communion and further mission. To be a member of the Church is not a consumer experience, often reflected in the statement, "I just want my communion." As if communion was another commodity. Communion is who we are through the grace of Jesus Christ. As St. Augustine told his local community when feeding them the Body and Blood of the Lord, "Become what you eat."

The values that will guide our planning effort are important. They are: communion, mercy, prayer, stewardship, and hope. Commitment to grow in each value will not only enhance our planning process, but will ultimately further the mission here at Holy Trinity and throughout the Diocese of Cheyenne.



## Everyday Stewardship

**The View from the Back of the Line:** Have you known that person? The one who leaves every person they encounter feeling a little more blessed for having met them? They're the friend you can count on when nothing is going well. They're the one who's always "doing" for others. They're never gossiping or sniping or complaining.

We wonder how they do it, how they have it in them. We're a little envious, even if we don't let ourselves acknowledge it.

That, folks, is what the view is like from the front of the line, gazing at those suckers in the way back and wondering why they're smiling so much.

We've all been at the front of a line and felt no shame about it. We show up early, we put in the time and the legwork, and we "earn" whatever it is we came for — sports tickets, the latest Apple product, whatever. That's how it works here on Earth, where the fastest win the race, the fittest survive and the first shall be first, always.

It's exactly why stewardship is such a tall order. Stewardship calls us to play by the rules of another kingdom — one where the richest have the least amount in their bank accounts and the happiest don't seem to have anything to show for it, at least materially.

If you have a person in your life who always seems happy "doing" for others, it's because by a boatload of God's grace, they play by the rules of the other place.

Watch and take notes — and don't be afraid to join them at the back of the line.




