## Thoughts of the Pastor...

Merry Christmas! After preparing for four weeks, we celebrate with enthusiasm, gratitude, and joy a most remarkable Solemnity: The Nativity of the Lord. We commemorate God's decision to join us in this human experience through the Incarnation. As Saint Paul says, "in the fullness of time, God sent his only Son..."

Listen to what Nathan Mitchell wrote regarding this Solemnity: "Christmas calls a community back to its origins by remembering Jesus' own beginnings as a human child. A prophet of God's reign, a judgment on the world and its projects. What the parish celebrates during this season is not primarily a birthday, but the beginning of a decisive new phase in the tempestuous history of God's hunger for human companions. The social concerns of the season are thus rooted in Jesus' proclamation of God's reign: the renunciation of patterns that oppress others (holding, climbing, commanding) and the formation of a new human community that voluntarily embraces those renunciations. It is an *adult* Christ that the community encounters during the Advent and Christmas cycles of Sundays and feasts: a Risen Lord who invites sinful people to become church. Christmas does not ask us to pretend we were back in Bethlehem, kneeling before a crib; it asks us to recognize that the wood of the crib became the wood of the cross."

Ah, blessed Christmas that moves us beyond the tinsel and glitter to consider what it means to not only be a companion of God, but members of his Church, called to proclaim the salvation of humanity through the outpouring of God's love. The babe in the manger is a historical fact. But it is God-man, the Christ, who suffered, died, and rose, who calls us beyond the tender image of the stable to embrace God's project of redemption.

Our Christmas Season will be the shortest possible since the Nativity of the Lord is on a Saturday. This weekend we also celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Commemorating the Holy Family, invites us to see, celebrate, and pray for our families as "domestic churches." Opportunities to love, serve, sacrifice, and grow abound in the experience of family, the first and preeminent place of formation in the faith.

This coming Saturday, January 1, 2022, we will celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, The Holy Mother of God. Because it is on a Saturday this year, you are dispensed from the obligation to celebrate this Holy Day. Next Sunday we will gather again to take another step in this unfolding mystery of the Incarnation as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. We will conclude our Christmas season on January 9, 2022 with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

Keep those decorations up, continue to wish others a Merry Christmas, and celebrate with family and friends this great and joyous season that carries a deep and tender mystery: Emmanuel, God is with us!

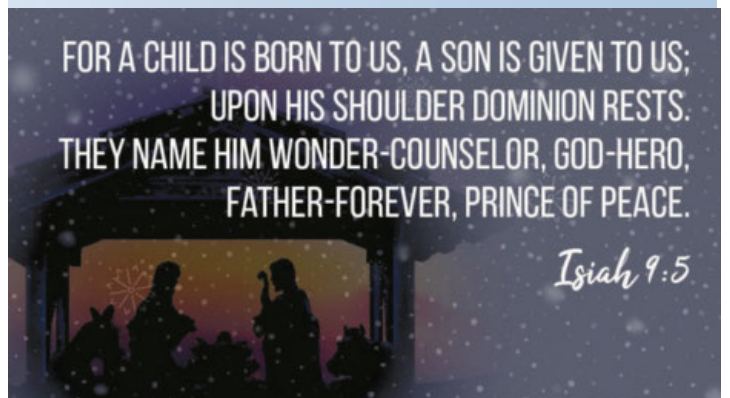

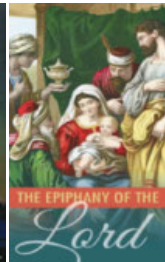
