

PASTORAL COUNCIL

- Q: Why do we put ashes on our forehead on Ash Wednesday?
- A: Ash Wednesday is a day of prayer, abstinence, fasting, and repentance. Blessed ashes are applied to the forehead in the sign of the cross while words such as "Remember, you are dust and to dust you shall return" or "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel" are said. The ashes and the words remind us of our mortality and our ongoing need for repentance. The ashes also remind us that life is short and our redemption comes through Jesus the Christ. Fr. Tom Margevicius said: "a return to ashes represents my worthlessness without God". *






