PASTORAL COUNCIL

Q: *How did Father's Day begin?*

A: As early as 1508, European Catholic nations celebrated fatherhood on St. Joseph's Day on March 19. Father's Day began in the United States in 1910 when a woman named Sonora Smart Dodd, in honor of her father, asked her Presbyterian pastor to give a Father's Day sermon. The pastor delivered the sermon on June 19 in Spokane, WA. Celebrating Father's Day spread throughout Spokane that year and throughout the nation thereafter. President Johnson issued the first official Father's Day proclamation to make it the third Sunday of June. President Nixon signed a bill into law making it a nationally recognized holiday. Father's Day recognizes the contribution of fathers to their families and to society.



Numbers

Your generous financial contributions, donations of food through us to Little Flower and Ascension parish and your continued use of our King Soopers Loyalty Program and Safeway reloadable gift cards are playing an important role in assisting many households in our community.

April 2011 through April 30, 2024

Client team – makes home visits and provides assistance

- 3,049 households in St. Michael's area assisted
- 3,233 adults and 2,995 children helped
- 36,539 miles traveled by Vincentians to assist others
- 7,767 hours of personal time
- Used \$922,920 of our funds, \$525,210 from SSVdP Metro, \$148,658 from grants, and \$110,471 from Catholic Charities, for housing, utilities, food, clothing, household goods, fuel, RTD passes, Rx, legal fees, medical charges, and other assistance. Total of \$1,797,259.

About 1.0% of the 7,946 confidential requests we have received since we started were from registered parishioners.

Eldercare team - includes five nursing center visits and we are expanding our ministry to include elderly parishioners.

- 30,001 miles driving to and from nursing facilities & homes

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVdP), a charitable organization dedicated to the service of the poor, was established by French university students in Paris in 1833, led by the Blessed Frederic Ozanam. SSVdP is active in 151 countries with about 850,000 members. The first SSVdP chapter in the United States was established in 1845 in St. Louis, MO.

Membership in the United States totals more than 85,000 in about 4,000 conferences. The national headquarters is in St. Louis. Members of the Society are known as "Vincentians," after St. Vincent de Paul, the patron of the organization. Vincentians are organized into parish conferences, a group of volunteers who gather together to grow spiritually and offer person-to-person service to those in need or living in poverty.



SSVdP activities in Denver began in 1876. Fr. Terry Kissell initiated the formation of our conference in April 2011. The conference was aggregated in 2014 in Paris, France. We are one of 29 conferences that make up the Denver Metro Council of the SSVdP. We work closely and often with our SSVdP Denver Metro Council and other parish conferences. Our food collection goes to Catholic Charities' Little Flower and Ascension parish. We sometimes partner with Catholic Charities for financial assistance.

Our funding is based on a fixed amount from St. Michael's Charity Fund, grants, individual donations, your Kroger Loyalty Number and Safeway card purchases, the Friends of the Poor Walk, and your SSVdP Poor Box contributions.

A Vincentian's perspective

"Do you have time for a quick cup of coffee?" I really didn't. I had a young child and a long list of chores. Still, I knew my neighbor was lonely and homebound, so I acquiesced. So began almost 6 years of visits. When she finally passed after a long battle, Thursdays seemed empty. The announcement that St. Vincent de Paul needed Eldercare volunteers happened that week. God works in mysterious ways.

Sometimes my residents are parked in front of the TV at Hampden Hills, as if hoping it will entertain them. Still, their eyes light up when they see me. One of them is 100, she can no longer see to read her Bible, so I read it to her. The other can't talk much, but I tell him all about my life.

Sometimes it is hard to find the time to go, sometimes I have trouble coming up with things to talk about. But God has taught me when you remember the forgotten, the rewards are endless. There are so many lonely souls that just need to know someone cares. I pray that more volunteers will help this vital ministry. Do you have time for a quick cup of coffee?


