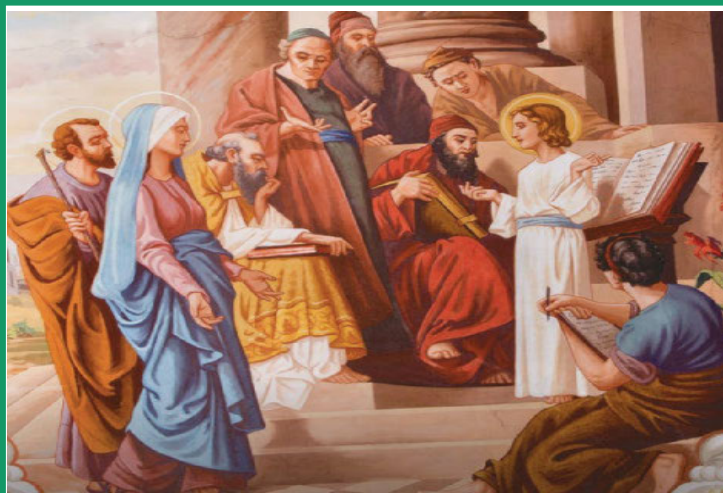

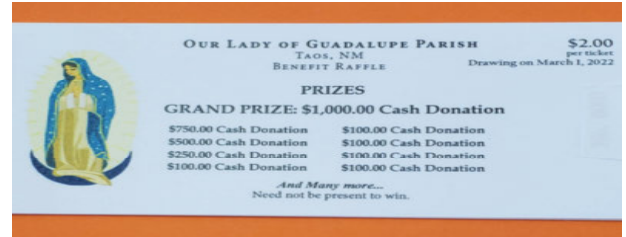

Dear family,

Usually when someone is hired for a position, even before one is hired, they are given a job description. It's a statement, the more concrete the better that outline what the employee's duties are and highlights what is expected of them. In today's Gospel, Jesus gives us His job description. Quoting the prophet Isaiah, what was written about Him, He proclaims that He is a specially anointed one sent by the Father to "proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord." No surprises here. Except, if we who are baptized in Christ, into the relationship of the Trinity, now are adopted as God's children, guess what? We also have the same job description! We who share in the life of God are expected to share in it fully, in all its life-giving aspects. 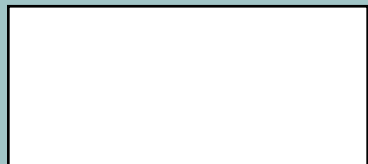
