Children: Jesus makes the wind and the sea peaceful. How would you have

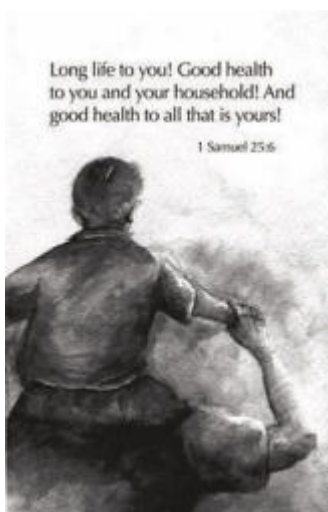
