## Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time –June 27, 2021

On a dark night, a young, frightened child emerges from a tent and seeks comfort from her Father.

“What do you do when you are afraid Mary?” asks this father portrayed in “The Chosen series.” “I say the words...(God’s Words from the prophet Isaiah) .. ***Fear not. You are mine!***”

These words, taught by him and tenderly recalled to the memory of his hurting and frightened daughter, were foundational for Mary’s recognizing Jesus as her Savior and God.

Decades later, as a desperate and tragically wounded adult, Mary would hear Jesus call her name and speak the words from Isaiah to her. And she would be healed!
