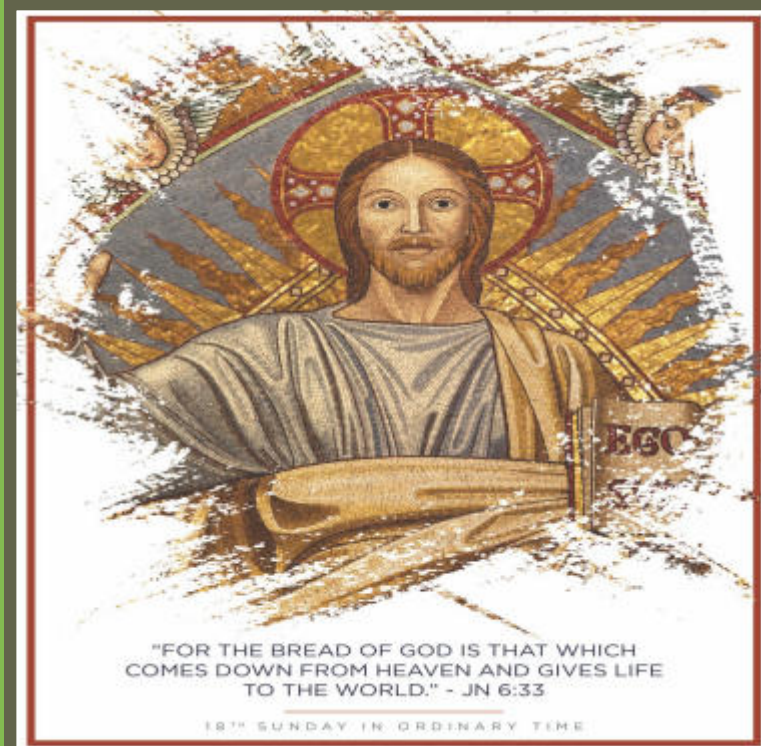

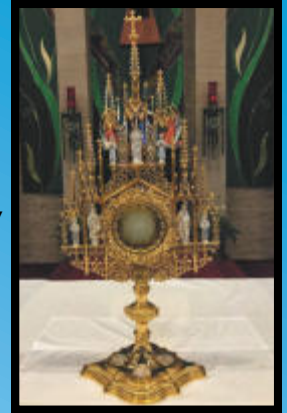

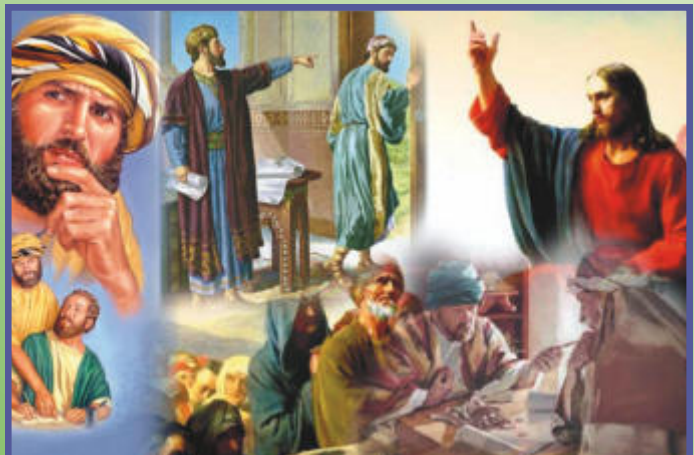
STEWARDSHIP CORNER
