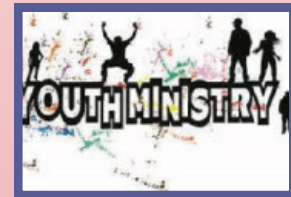
## K of C BINGO

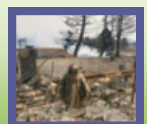
### RE: ADVANCING MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP (AMD)
