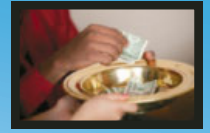

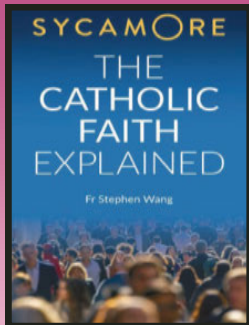

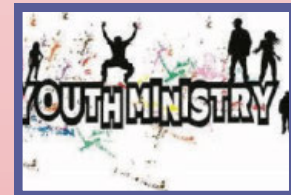
K of C BINGO

SOUP KITCHEN



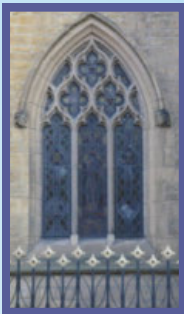
The food collection for the Soup Kitchen at St. Joseph is the 1st Sunday of every month. Our gifts help feed those who are hungry in our Valley.

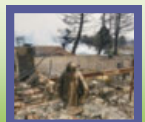
