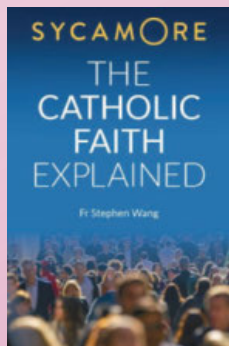

Sycamore is a great place to start. We have Sycamore groups including a Young Adult’s group. Evening, day and weekend groups are available.

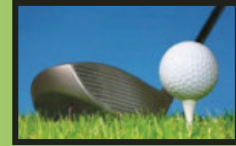

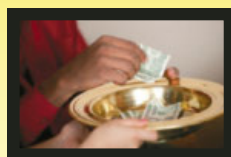

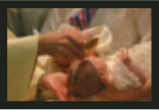
