Hospital Visits: At the moment the hospital is not allowing priests in for hospital visits. We do have technological means to help family members such as phone or Zoom. However, Memorial Hospital of Sweetwater does allow priests to visit for end life situations. Please contact the parish office if your loved one is in need of a priest and we will see how we can best assist them.

SCM Church Organ: As we begin to bring music back to our celebrations, we have found that our organ is in need of refurbishing. With environmental swings of dryness, blowing snow, and heavy rains coupled with the inactivity over the last 18 months we have found the organ to be inoperable.

The age of the organ (almost 100 years old) requires special knowledge to refurbish. We are working to get an evaluation and estimate of the extent of needed repairs.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Deserts can be lonely, isolated, and treacherous places. When a person wanders in a desert, they can easily get disoriented, dehydrated, confused, lost, and vulnerable. Temptation is at its peak, especially when confronted with something that may offer some respite or relief, even a mirage. Deserts can bring us to our weakest moment and tempt our faith. The Christian journey can be described as a desert experience as we vacillate back and forth, falling victim to the mirages of our lives versus the true, life-giving water offered by God. We need a burning bush experience in our lives that convinces us of the power of God and reveals Him as the "I am" of all existence.

Moses was leading his flock across the desert when he found himself at Mount Horeb. Mountains give us a fuller perspective of life, a panoramic view of what would otherwise be hidden from the limitations of our sight. That's when Moses met God. We have to find our way to a mountain experience where our vantage point can take on a wider view of life.



Many things can do this for us: the birth of a child, the death of someone we love, the joy that comes from marveling at the beauty of God's work, the pondering of life's mysteries, and the ache of longing found deep within our souls. There are many things in life that can wake us up, give us a clearer, better view of things and become occasions where a bush may burn and God's presence as the eternal uncreated One is revealed.

God is very patient and gives us the time and space we need to figure things out and bear some

good fruit. He doesn't rush to cut us down or get frustrated with our barrenness. But we have to remember that the desert journeys of our lives come with some risks. The major risk is that we will mistakenly believe that the mirages are real. Thus, we fall victim to thinking that the respite and refreshment we seek is discovered in a place other than where it actually is. Our faith and the life of the Church are the safeguards we need to keep us properly orientated so that we don't get lost or confused and stay on course.

And he told them this parable: "There once was a person who had a fig tree planted in his orchard, and when he came in search of fruit on it but found none, he said to the gardener, 'For three years now I have come in search of fruit on this fig tree but have found none. So cut it down. Why should it exhaust the soil?'" - Lk 13:6-7

The Gift of Lent

The Season of Lent is a gift from God



1. Clip the Lenten Regulations out of the bulletin and tack them in a prominent place for all in the household to know what is to be observed.
2. Suggested reading is the Gospel of Mark. Let's set the goal that by the end of Lent, all of us will have read the Gospel of Mark. It is the first and shortest of the Gospels. It opens with, "The beginning of the Gospel of Jesus Christ the Son of God". Great way to start, but Mark's Gospel has no ending. Two endings have been tacked on but you can tell they do not fit. The absence of an ending is intentional. Each of us is to write our own ending, but not our own Gospel. During this Lent read the Gospel of Mark from the beginning through chapter 15 verse 8. As you read pray to be transformed by the words and converted. Then on Easter Sunday, begin writing your ending with verse 9 saying what you want to say as the lead line for your conclusion to the Gospel of Mark.
3. Think of the one person among your acquaintances you will directly invite back to regular church attendance and participation. It could be family, a relative, a co-worker, a friend, a spouse, etc.
4. Daily Mass is a great Lenten practice. If you cannot attend daily, pick one day when the applied intention is for a family member or friend and attend on that day to pray for him/her.
5. Almsgiving is a traditional Lenten practice. You could bring a non-perishable food item for the poor, given out from Loaves & Fishes Soup Kitchen & Pantry the first weekend of the month. These are weekends when we also take financial offerings for the poor.
6. Stations of the Cross and Benediction are favorite devotions.

The Way of the Cross is celebrated in English at 6 pm, SCM Church and in Spanish 7pm at SCM Church on Fridays.

7. Emphasize family prayer. These can be simple prayers before going to bed such as, with family holding hands, "Heavenly Father keep us in your love so that we may awaken in the morning refreshed for another day in your company. Amen." ***Do something daily with the family.***
