**Covid update:** Holy Spirit Pastoral Council met on March 15 and recommended discontinuing covid precautions following the direction of the Diocese of Cheyenne COVID-19 Response Team. The diocesan statement can be seen below. At this time, the use of face coverings is optional at all activities and liturgies. Please share the sign of peace as you desire but please also observe the preferences of those near you. Those who desire to receive communion in their mouth are able to receive at any place in the communion procession. Those who distribute Holy Communion will wear a face covering and use hand sanitizer at this time. Let us continue to pray for God's grace to love our neighbor as we love ourselves.

**From the Diocese of Cheyenne:** On February 25, 2022, the CDC issued new guidance regarding indoor masking. Also, Governor Gordon announced that Wyoming's COVID-19 Public Health Emergency declaration is over, effective March 14. Therefore, the COVID-19 Response Team recommends all COVID-19 protocols for the Diocese of Cheyenne be discontinued. Exceptions are that there will be no distribution of the Precious Blood, and the medical recommendation is to wear face coverings during distribution of Holy Communion and food service. In addition, take precautions based on the COVID-19 Community Level in your area, which can be low, medium, or high. Actualización de Covid: El Consejo Pastoral del Espíritu Santo se reunió el 15 de marzo y recomendó suspender las precauciones de covid siguiendo las instrucciones del Equipo de Respuesta COVID-19 de la Diócesis de Cheyenne. La declaración diocesana se puede ver a continuación. En este momento, el uso de cubrebocas es opcional en todas las actividades y liturgias. Por favor, comparta el signo de paz como desee, pero también observe las preferencias de los que están cerca de usted. Aquellos que desean recibir la comunión en su boca pueden recibir en cualquier lugar de la procesión de la comunión. Aquellos que distribuyen la Sagrada Comunión usarán una cubierta facial y usarán desinfectante de manos en este momento. Sigamos orando por la gracia de Dios para amar a nuestro prójimo como nos amamos a nosotros mismos. De la Diócesis de Cheyenne: El 25 de febrero de 2022, los CDC emitieron una nueva guía con respecto al enmascaramiento en interiores. Además, el gobernador Gordon anunció que la declaración de emergencia de salud pública COVID-19 de Wyoming ha terminado, a partir del 14 de marzo. Por lo tanto, el Equipo de Respuesta COVID-19 recomienda que se suspendan todos los protocolos COVID-19 para la Diócesis de Cheyenne. Las excepciones son que no habrá distribución de la Preciosa Sangre, y la recomendación médica es usar cubiertas faciales durante la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión y el servicio de alimentos. 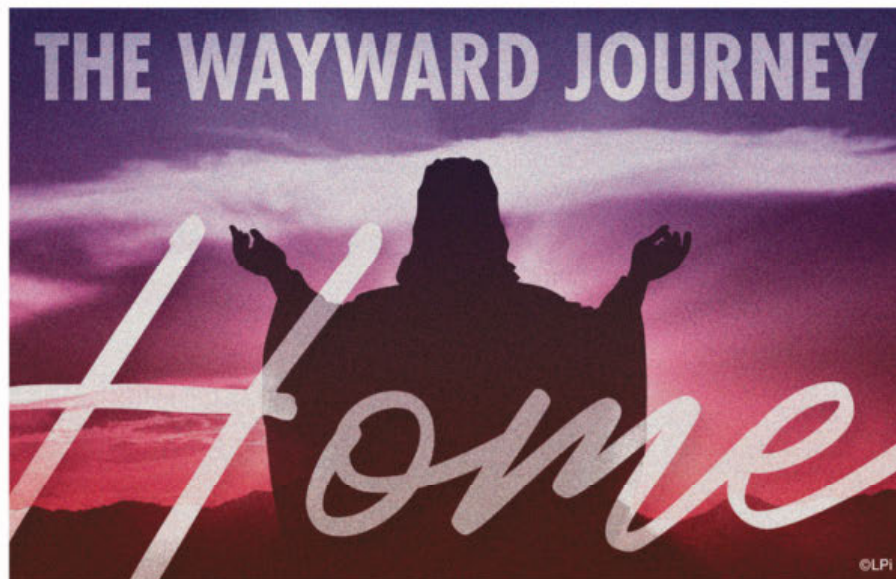


## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

God's love story reveals itself in our stories, experiences, and aspirations. We are all prodigal sons and daughters. There are many times in our lives when we would "sell our souls" in order to pursue our passions. We pursued what we wanted without regard for others or God. We have sowed our oats, thrown ourselves into careless pleasures, spent what we know we ought to have saved, turned our backs on those we love and abused gifts we have been given. We even hit bottom and realized the silliness and self-destruction of it all. We needed to come home. We knew we erred and needed a gentle presence to show us God's unconditional love. This wayward journey home changed us.

As much as we need to be welcomed, we are also the one who needs to do the welcoming and mercy giving. Those we love need our guidance, but they don't always take it. We know that what they are doing is off the mark, self-destructive and wrong. We have to let them go and let it happen, even though they might get hurt. As we



wait and hope, they choose to make their way back to us. They don't need us to judge them. They have done enough of that to themselves. We immediately embrace them and are just happy they're home. God uses us to help heal them. Knowing how much we craved understanding and forgiveness ourselves, we can now freely give it away. God uses what he has taught us to teach others.

We are also the entitled ones. At least we "think" we are entitled. After all, we work hard for what we have. We cannot get our

heads around the idea that someone can get something that I really deserve! If I do what I'm supposed to do, I ought to be rewarded for that, right? If I do something wrong, I ought to pay the consequences. This is justice, isn't it? This is not God's justice. God is all about love, mercy, compassion, and forgiveness. God's justice is love freely given without merit. We carry the stories of the prodigal son, the unconditional forgiving father, and the entitled angry brother with us. When we make friends with all three, humbly telling those stories to others makes us Christ's ambassadors.

## The Gift of Lent

### The Season of Lent is a gift from God



1. Clip the Lenten Regulations out of the bulletin and tack them in a prominent place for all in the household to know what is to be observed.
2. Suggested reading is the Gospel of Mark. Let's set the goal that by the end of Lent, all of us will have read the Gospel of Mark. It is the first and shortest of the Gospels. It opens with, "The beginning of the Gospel of Jesus Christ the Son of God". Great way to start, but Mark's Gospel has no ending. Two endings have been tacked on but you can tell they do not fit. The absence of an ending is intentional. Each of us is to write our own ending, but not our own Gospel. During this Lent read the Gospel of Mark from the beginning through chapter 15 verse 8. As you read pray to be transformed by the words and converted. Then on Easter Sunday, begin writing your ending with verse 9 saying what you want to say as the lead line for your conclusion to the Gospel of Mark.
3. Think of the one person among your acquaintances you will directly invite back to regular church attendance and participation. It could be family, a relative, a co-worker, a friend, a spouse, etc.
4. Daily Mass is a great Lenten practice. If you cannot attend daily, pick one day when the applied intention is for a family member or friend and attend on that day to pray for him/her.
5. Almsgiving is a traditional Lenten practice. You could bring a non-perishable food item for the poor, given out from Loaves & Fishes Soup Kitchen & Pantry the first weekend of the month. These are weekends when we also take financial offerings for the poor.
6. Stations of the Cross and Benediction are favorite devotions.
7. Emphasize family prayer. These can be simple prayers before going to bed such as, with family holding hands, "Heavenly Father keep us in your love so that we may awaken in the morning refreshed for another day in your company. Amen."
