Covid update: Holy Spirit Pastoral Council met on March 15 and recommended discontinuing covid precautions following the direction of the Diocese of Cheyenne COVID-19 Response Team. The diocesan statement can be seen below. At this time, the use of face coverings is optional at all activities and liturgies. Please share the sign of peace as you desire but please also observe the preferences of those near you. Those who desire to receive communion in their mouth are able to receive at any place in the communion procession. Those who distribute Holy Communion will wear a face covering and use hand sanitizer at this time. Let us continue to pray for God's grace to love our neighbor as we love ourselves.

From the Diocese of Cheyenne: On February 25, 2022, the CDC issued new guidance regarding indoor masking. Also, Governor Gordon announced that Wyoming's COVID-19 Public Health Emergency declaration is over, effective March 14. Therefore, the COVID-19 Response Team recommends all COVID-19 protocols for the Diocese of Cheyenne be discontinued. Exceptions are that there will be no distribution of the Precious Blood, and the medical recommendation is to wear face coverings during distribution of Holy Communion and food service. In addition, take precautions based on the COVID-19 Community Level in your area, which can be low, medium, or high. 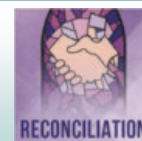

Actualización de Covid: El Consejo Pastoral del Espíritu Santo se reunió el 15 de marzo y recomendó suspender las precauciones de covid siguiendo las instrucciones del Equipo de Respuesta COVID-19 de la Diócesis de Cheyenne. La declaración diocesana se puede ver a continuación. En este momento, el uso de cubrebocas es opcional en todas las actividades y liturgias. Por favor, comparta el signo de paz como desee, pero también observe las preferencias de los que están cerca de usted. Aquellos que desean recibir la comunión en su boca pueden recibir en cualquier lugar de la procesión de la comunión. Aquellos que distribuyen la Sagrada Comunión usarán una cubierta facial y usarán desinfectante de manos en este momento. Sigamos orando por la gracia de Dios para amar a nuestro prójimo como nos amamos a nosotros mismos.

De la Diócesis de Cheyenne: El 25 de febrero de 2022, los CDC emitieron una nueva guía con respecto al enmascaramiento en interiores. Además, el gobernador Gordon anunció que la declaración de emergencia de salud pública COVID-19 de Wyoming ha terminado, a partir del 14 de marzo. Por lo tanto, el Equipo de Respuesta COVID-19 recomienda que se suspendan todos los protocolos COVID-19 para la Diócesis de Cheyenne. Las excepciones son que no habrá distribución de la Preciosa Sangre, y la recomendación médica es usar cubiertas faciales durante la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión y el servicio de alimentos. GOSPEL MEDITATION

ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

We love to make examples out of those who have erred and done wrong. Publicly punishing others serves as a means of demonstrating the consequences for what is deemed inappropriate or wrongful behavior. While this may appear an effective way of achieving conformity to established rules, it runs the real risk of distorting motivation. Obviously, we want people to do what is right and pursue healthy, virtuous behaviors and ideals. But is fear of punishment ever the best motivation for avoiding one action in favor of another?

Doing something out of fear is never healthy. Focusing exclusively on our behavior and what others expect or think, leads to living life with a self-focused superficiality. We become more concerned about protecting ourselves from something negative and unpleasant, than investing ourselves in the freedom, wonder and awe of being human! We can still find our way to the unacceptable or inappropriate behavior as long as we do not get caught! Being a whole, focused, and God-centered human being requires more. It demands an investment of the heart. Virtuous, moral, and mature lifestyles reflective of the Gospel necessitate love.



When we experience and recognize love, God's unconditional love, in the depth of our soul, we fall in love with what we have found. We then find ourselves leaving destructive and sinful actions behind in search of something more holy, dignified, true, integral, and loving. This is really "mercy realized." God's tremendous, loving, eternal forgiveness and willingness to bring us back to something more real and tender is transformational. The respect for myself that I receive from God is so life changing that it causes me to run quickly away from anything sinful and self-destructive to things that are whole and holy.

There are many people who want nothing more than to judge or criticize us. What would actually stoning the woman caught in adultery really accomplish? Nothing more than the inflation of the already self-righteous egos of a few men who think they have power. They have no power because they are sinners too, just like everyone else. What all of us have is the humble ability to express sorrow for pursuing destructive thoughts and actions and receive the power of God's mercy. Then, Jesus' request to "go and sin no more" will be one we proudly heed and follow.
