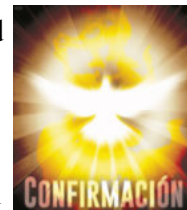

## Shared Prayer and Study: The Early History of Catholicism in Wyoming

On July 5, 1840, Fr. Peter De Smet served as principal celebrant of the first Eucharistic assembly located within the territory that would eventually become



Wyoming. The rendezvous outside of what today is the town of Daniel now contains a monument and small chapel commemorating this celebration, and the Diocese celebrates

Eucharist at this location each July to remember this Eucharistic gathering. The history of De Smet's arrival in Wyoming, those among whom he ministered, and the context of his time provide great insight not only into this first Eucharistic assembly but also who we are as the local Church of the Diocese of Cheyenne today. Essential to the beginnings of the Catholic Church in Wyoming is Fr. De Smet's ministry among Native communities, his eventual involvement in the federal government's establishment of the reservation system, and the shared affection and respect between some Native communities and De Smet.

To explore this history further, the Office of Pastoral Formation of the Diocese of Cheyenne will coordinate a Diocese-wide experience of prayer and study with the book, *Come, Blackrobe*. Through our shared study, we will have the opportunity to learn about our faith, the historical forces that have contextualized our faith, and how we can understand ourselves as the Church in the Diocese of Cheyenne in contemporary times.

**Covid update:** Holy Spirit Pastoral Council met on March 15 and recommended discontinuing covid precautions following the direction of the Diocese of Cheyenne COVID-19 Response Team. The diocesan statement can be seen below. At this time, the use of face coverings is optional at all activities and liturgies. Please share the sign of peace as you desire but please also observe the preferences of those near you. Those who desire to receive communion in their mouth are able to receive at any place in the communion procession. Those who distribute Holy Communion will wear a face covering and use hand sanitizer at this time. Let us continue to pray for God's grace to love our neighbor as we love ourselves.

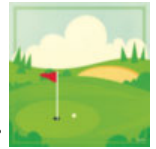
**From the Diocese of Cheyenne:** On February 25, 2022, the CDC issued new guidance regarding indoor masking.

Also, Governor Gordon announced that Wyoming's COVID-19 Public Health Emergency declaration is over, effective March 14. Therefore, the COVID-19 Response Team recommends all COVID-19 protocols for the Diocese of Cheyenne be discontinued. Exceptions are that there will be no distribution of the Precious Blood, and the medical recommendation is to wear face coverings during distribution of Holy Communion and food service. In addition, take precautions based on the COVID-19 Community Level in your area, which can be low, medium, or high. ## Ascension of the Lord

### Question:

Couldn't Jesus have done more good if he stayed on earth, rather than ascended into heaven?

### Answer:

This is an interesting question! During his earthly life, Jesus gave sight to the blind, healed paralytics, drove out demons, and fed thousands with only a few loaves of bread. Imagine what he could have done if he'd never ascended into heaven! Imagine what our world could be! It's an interesting thought to consider, especially as the world faces challenges that only seem to deepen and expand. Yet at the Last Supper, Jesus says, "It is better for you if I go." Why? His response must have seemed strange to the Apostles at the time. In his place, Jesus says, he will send the Paraclete, the Comforter, the Advocate. He promises to send the Holy Spirit.

Jesus' departure allows the Apostles to become the leaders he has formed them to be. Jesus is no longer situated in only one geographical location, and his Church will never be a political kingdom. Soon after the Ascension, we celebrate Pentecost — the descent of the Holy Spirit and the radical empowerment of the followers of Jesus. We share in that empowerment and in that mission. Jesus is present in the sacraments, and he is present in us. Through our faith, hope, and love, we are called to be the good he does here on earth!
