

- Here at St. Ambrose we are continually working to keep you and your loved ones safe. We are still sanitizing every pew after every weekend Mass and focusing on touch surfaces on doors and in restrooms. We like to highlight that we have an abundance of fresh air mixed in our air handlers and we still add quite a bit of fresh air to the building even though we are in heating mode. For larger gatherings we have the ability to open the fresh air dampers even more we take the air quality quite seriously. During the week the restrooms are sanitized and public areas are deep cleaned and limited to excessive use. If you have any questions about our protocols please reach out to the office and we'll be happy to answer them.
- Those who are sick, vulnerable or who care for others with underlying chronic health conditions, as well as those not feeling well, are encouraged to refrain from going to Church and remain at home. They are encouraged to watch and participate in livestreamed or televised Mass. You may call the parish office and request to receive Holy Communion at home.

St. Ambrose will permanently continue to offer our Sunday video Masses for shut-ins and those who are ill. Due to the size and health airflow in our chapel, mask wearing is optional. The reception of Holy Communion on the tongue, the universal norm of the Latin Rite, is again allowed. Please, if you are ill or think you might be ill whether with COVID or something else, PLEASE STAY HOME. It is not a sin to miss Mass when ill.



Bible Bits

January 2, 2022

We celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord this Sunday (i.e. Christ being revealed to the Gentiles - people who are not Jews). The Apostle Paul discloses in the Second Reading (Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6) how he received special revelation (verse 6) "that the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel." So, Gentiles as well as Jews are joined together in the ministry of God revealing Himself through the Church. The interesting thing about this revelation to Paul, which he had been proclaiming to Gentiles as well as the Jews, is that after he received it, according to what he wrote in the Book of Galatians (2:1-2), he discussed it with the leaders of the Church in order to be sure that he "might not be running, or have run, in vain." The important thing to note about all of this is that even the protagonist Paul, who is credited with writing a huge portion of the New Testament, submitted his special revelation from God to the authority of the Church.
