

- Here at St. Ambrose we are continually working to keep you and your loved ones safe. We are still sanitizing every pew after every weekend Mass and focusing on touch surfaces on doors and in restrooms. We like to highlight that we have an abundance of fresh air mixed in our air handlers and we still add quite a bit of fresh air to the building even though we are in heating mode. For larger gatherings we have the ability to open the fresh air dampers even more we take the air quality quite seriously. During the week the restrooms are sanitized and public areas are deep cleaned and limited to excessive use. If you have any questions about our protocols please reach out to the office and we'll be happy to answer them.
- Those who are sick, vulnerable or who care for others with underlying chronic health conditions, as well as those not feeling well, are encouraged to refrain from going to Church and remain at home. They are encouraged to watch and participate in livestreamed or televised Mass. You may call the parish office and request to receive Holy Communion at home.

St. Ambrose will permanently continue to offer our Sunday video Masses for shut-ins and those who are ill. Due to the size and health airflow in our chapel, mask wearing is optional. The reception of Holy Communion on the tongue, the universal norm of the Latin Rite, is again allowed. Please, if you are ill or think you might be ill whether with COVID or something else, PLEASE STAY HOME. It is not a sin to miss Mass when ill.

Bible Bits

January 16, 2022

Apparently, how the church should work is very important to the Holy Spirit. In this Sunday's Second Reading (1 Corinthians 12:4-11) we find part of one of the most extensive New Testament passages dealing with the subject of spiritual gifts that Christians are given. The Apostle Paul tells us the Holy Spirit gives each one of us a gift or gifts which we are to use in the church for the benefit of the church. A metaphor would be a choir: different parts (soprano, alto, tenor, base, etc.) but a unified sound. Paul describes how different aspects of various gifts from assorted individuals work together to produce desired results such as "wisdom" and/or "knowledge." In the verse following today's reading (v 12) the apostle compares our inter-dependence to the workings of the various parts of the human body: "As a body is one though it has many parts, and all of the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ."
