

KEEPING YOU SAFE DURING COVID-19

- Here at St. Ambrose we are continually working to keep you and your loved ones safe. We are still sanitizing every pew after every weekend Mass and focusing on touch surfaces on doors and in restrooms. We like to highlight that we have an abundance of fresh air mixed in our air handlers and we still add quite a bit of fresh air to the building even though we are in heating mode. For larger gatherings we have the ability to open the fresh air dampers even more - we take the air quality quite seriously. During the week the restrooms are sanitized and public areas are deep cleaned and limited to excessive use. If you have any questions about our protocols please reach out to the office and we'll be happy to answer them.
- Those who are sick, vulnerable or who care for others with underlying chronic health conditions, as well as those not feeling well, are encouraged to refrain from going to Church and remain at home. They are encouraged to watch and participate in livestreamed or televised Mass. You may call the parish office and request to receive Holy Communion at home.

St. Ambrose will permanently continue to offer our Sunday video Masses for shut-ins and those who are ill. Due to the size and health airflow in our chapel, mask wearing is optional. The reception of Holy Communion on the tongue, the universal norm of the Latin Rite, is again allowed. Please, if you are ill or think you might be ill whether with COVID or something else,

PLEASE STAY HOME. It is not a sin to miss Mass when ill.

Bible Bits

January 23, 2022

Many Christians find interesting the general consensus among Bible scholars that the writer of the Gospel of Luke also wrote the book of Acts. Among early Christians, students of the Bible point to the "we" passages of Acts, beginning in 16:10 (note: before that verse the book says "they" went here or there, but at this point and beyond, "we" went here or there) and held that Luke joined Paul when the latter was in the region of Mysia. Various modern scholars point to other reasons for the "we" passages, but regardless, in today's Gospel Reading (Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21) Jesus reads from Isaiah, (Lk 4:18-19) the Lord "has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor . . . proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord." And finally, (verse 21) "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." Yes, most assuredly, Jesus Christ is fulfilling - He satisfies our every need.




