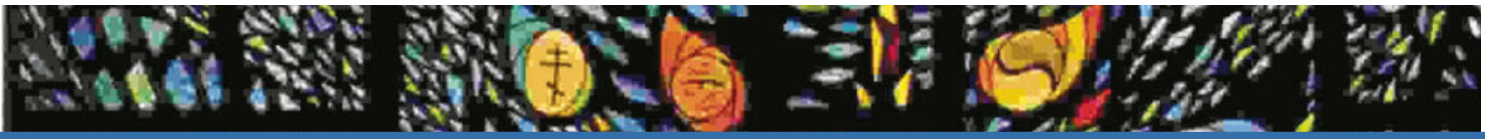

## Bible Bits

April 14, 2024

Acts 3:13-15, 17-19 is the First Reading for the Third Sunday of Easter, and it describes a portion of St. Peter's message delivered from what was called "Solomon's Portico," or "**Solomon's Porch.**" It was a colonnade or cloister, located on the eastern side of the Jerusalem Temple's Outer Court. The point of Peter's message is that people must "repent . . . and be converted" (verse 19). Note the order: "repent," then "be converted." Many Christians are confused about the difference between repentance and conversion and will give the definition of conversion — to turn around and go in the opposite direction — when describing repentance. Actually, repentance is a mystery, wherein God is already working in a person. "Repent" is a translation of the Greek word *μετάνοια* (*metanoia*), i.e., to have a change of heart and mind. In reality, if you repent, you will want to be converted. Note Acts 11:18, "God has granted life-giving repentance to the Gentiles too."

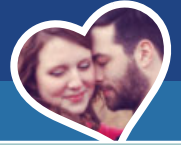

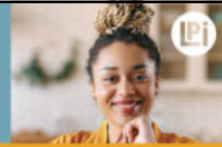
