

Bible Bits

May 11, 2025:

The First Reading for the Fourth Sunday of Easter is Acts 13:14, 43-52. It excludes verses 16-41, wherein we are told the Apostle Paul is preaching to the Jews gathered in the synagogue of Antioch of Pisidia. Paul says the Church is actually the fulfillment of Pharisaic Judaism — that it's the logical conclusion of being a Jew. Paul always preached to the Jews first, and then to the Gentiles (e.g. Acts 24:10-21 and 26:2-23). When he preached the Gospel, his words were favorably received, and so he was invited to return on the next Sabbath to preach more: but via word of mouth, a large number of Gentiles from the city were also attracted, and that was very upsetting to the Jews. So, they exhibited hostility to Paul and others in his company. The Apostle says to the Jews (verse 46), "since you reject [God's word]...we now turn to the Gentiles." Whether Jew or Gentile, according to verse 48, "All who were destined for eternal life came to believe."


