THE FEAST OF THE ARCHANGELS

September 29 marks the Feast of the Archangels: Michael, Gabriel and Rafael. All three are mentioned in Bible and have heralded great happenings in the history of the world. They are considered ‘saints’ since the early Church venerated them by naming churches after them, invoking their names in prayer and asking for their intercession.

St. MICHAEL – He is the leader of all angels and of the Army of God. He has four main responsibilities or offices: to combat Satan, to rescue souls from the power of the enemy at the hour of their death, to be the champion of all Christians and the Church itself, and to call people from their life on earth to their heavenly judgment. St. Michael is invoked for protection from lethal enemies and is the patron saint of soldiers, police and doctors.

St. GABRIEL – He served as a messenger from God to certain people. In the Old Testament, Gabriel appears to the prophet Daniel to explain his visions. In the New Testament, he first appears to Zacharias, the father of John the Baptist. He tells him, “Do not be afraid, Zechariah, because your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall name him John.” (LK 1:13) After Elizabeth conceives and is 6 months pregnant, Gabriel then appears to Mary, who is betrothed to Joseph in Nazareth and tells her, “Hail, favored one! The Lord is with you...Then the angel said to her, ‘Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus.’” (LK 1:28-31) He is the patron saint of messengers, telecommunication workers and postal workers.

St. RAPHAEL – He is often pictured or described as holding a flask or sounding a trumpet. He is the patron saint of pharmacists, the blind, physicians, and shepherds. Raphael first appears disguised in human form as the traveling companion of Tobit’s son, Tobias. During the course of the journey, Raphael’s protective influence is shown in many ways, including binding a demon in the desert of Upper Egypt. In the New Testament, he is depicted in John 5:1-4 in reference to the archangel’s healing powers at the pool of Bethesda.

Dear Parish Family,

In this weekend's gospel from the Gospel of Mark (Mk 9:38-43, 45, 47-48), we hear John say, "Teacher, we saw a man using your name to expel demons..." William Barclay, the Bible Commentator, stated that "In the time of Jesus, everyone believed in demons and was very well aware that there was a common way to exorcise these demons: If one could get to know the name of a still more powerful spirit such as the Spirit of God and command the evil demon in that name to come out of that person, the demon was supposed to be powerless to resist. The demon could not stand against the might of the more powerful name.

This is the kind of picture we have here in today's gospel. John had seen a man using the **all-powerful name of Jesus** to defeat the demons, and therefore, he tried to stop him because this man that was driving out demons was not one of the intimate band of the disciples. But Jesus declared that no man could do a mighty work in his name and be altogether his enemy. Then Jesus laid down the great principle that "**he who is not against us is for us**" (Mark 9:40). – William Barclay

In the face of evil, we definitely need the power of God to be on our side, but the question we need to ask ourselves is not whether or not God is on our side; we need to ask ourselves the question, "**Am I on God's side?**" (Mark 9:40). God will never abandon us during our time of battle with Satan; however, being the perfect gentleman that he is, he's not going to force his way into our minds, hearts and souls *if* we have abandoned him by casting the 10 Commandments aside, by serving other gods, by taking his name in vain, by not keeping holy the Sabbath, by not loving our neighbor, etc. If we expect God to be there for us when we are experiencing stress, distress, temptation, sin and/or peril, then we need to step up to the plate NOW by letting God know through our thoughts, words and actions that we are not just *fair weathered friends*; we are in a committed relationship with him in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health. At this time, in the midst of the church crisis, I have to ask myself, "If I can be priest in the Catholic Church when priests are honored and respected, can I also be a priest in the Catholic Church when the heat of the scandal rises to fever pitch? Am I a "fan" of God, just a friend of his when things are looking good, or am I 'true-blue, dyed in the wool' servant that is willing to pick up my cross and follow him?"

Family and friends, please pray for me that I will have what it takes to be on God's side (Mark 9:40) and to cast out demons with you in the **all-powerful name of Jesus**: "There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4: 12).

"O Jesus, my Savior, my Lord and my God, my God and my all, with your sacrifice of the Cross you redeemed us and defeated the power of Satan. I beg you to deliver me from every evil presence and every evil influence. I ask in **your name**, I ask You for the same of your wounds, I ask you for the sake of your blood, I ask you for the sake of your cross, I ask you through the intercession of Mary, immaculate and sorrowful. May the blood and the water that flow from your side wash over me to purify me, deliver me, heal me. AMEN." 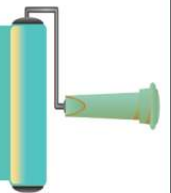
