Dear Parish Family,

Today, as we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, we get to experience not only his baptism, but our share in that one baptism as well, for St. Paul tells us in his letter to the Ephesians, "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call, one Lord, one faith, ONE BAPTISM [emphasis mine], one God and Father of us all.

Can you imagine the power we could experience if we truly believed that the baptism that you and I each experienced "many moons" ago (or just recently) was *really* and *actually* a share in the ONE BAPTISM of the Lord, and that through this ONE BAPTISM, each and every one of us who have been baptized get to share in the blessings, favors, grace and effects of the Lord's baptism, meaning that if we have been baptized through the Lord, with the Lord and in the Lord, we become one with his body, partakers of his divine nature and heirs to the kingdom of heaven: "Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him by baptism into his death, so that as Christ as raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in the newness of life (Romans 6:3-4).

Our share in this ONE BAPTISM should either cause our heart to skip a beat or cause it to pound faster because of this good news, knowing that although you and I were not present that day with Jesus Christ when he was baptized there in the Jordan River, we were ONE with him when he was immersed into the river (a foreshadowing of his death on the cross); we were ONE with him while he was in the water (a foreshadowing of his burial) and we were ONE with him when he came out of the water (a foreshadowing of his resurrection).

I love how St. Basil (364-370) describes baptism: "Our Lord made a covenant with us through baptism in order to give eternal life, the water being the symbol of death, the Spirit giving the pledge of eternal life.

"The association of water and the Spirit is explained by the twofold purpose for which baptism was instituted, namely to destroy sin in us so that it could never again give birth to death, and to enable us to live by the Spirit and so win the reward of holiness.

"The water into which the body enters as into a **tomb** symbolizes the death; the Spirit instills into us his life-giving power, awakening our souls from the death of sin to the life that they had in the beginning. This then is what is meant to be born again of water and the Spirit. We die in the water, and we come to life again through the Spirit. Through the Holy Spirit we are restored to paradise, we ascend to the kingdom of heaven, and we are reinstated as adopted sons and daughters." -- St. Basil

With this in mind, let us not take our baptism for granted. Let us be mindful each and every time we process into church or recess out by renewing our baptismal promises (by dipping our hands into the holy water font and making the sign of cross), not out of habit, but out of a deep desire to profess our faith before and after Mass, but most importantly, out of a deep desire to profess our faith during Mass!

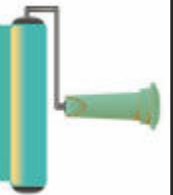
