Our parish and our students at St. Marguerite Catholic School have been celebrating Catholic Schools Week in many ways this week, beginning last Sunday with our student choir singing at the 10:30 Mass under the direction of Mrs. TerMeer, our music teacher. Monday was a day for giving thanks to all of the local businesses, individuals and local government entities who have shown unfailing generosity to SMCS currently and throughout the years.

Tuesday was the light-hearted “Smarty-Pants Day” which included a student Spelling Bee and an opportunity for all the students to showcase their individual talents. On Wednesday, all of the SMCS teachers, staff and volunteers were treated to a thank-you breakfast in the parish center. Thursday was the celebration of our student’s families that featured the Science Fair and an invitation for the parents of the younger students to join their kids for lunch. That evening, the school had their annual Open House for parents and parishioners to enjoy the student art work which adorns the hall and classrooms.

The week was topped off on Friday with the celebration of the School Mass at which Father Ken Vialpando spoke to the students about vocations and his own “calling” to become a priest.

Our Principal, Mrs. Trisha Kirkbride says, “As part of Catholic Schools Week, we recognize the artwork that our students have created throughout the year under the guidance of our artist-in-residence, Miss Caroline.”

Part of that artwork will live on at SMCS for generations to come as reflected in the beautiful mosaic mural that now adorns more than an entire wall in the lobby of our school. Fittingly, the central figure of the mural is Jesus Christ and His Sacred Heart. Devotion to The Sacred Heart of Jesus was brought to the world by our own St. Marguerite Marie Alacoque. Local artist and Muralist Roger Whiting generously came in and taught our students of the history and shared his journey of how he became a mosaic artist. The students were given a topic to draw images of and then he took those drawings and incorporated them into the mural. Whiting created Jesus and His Sacred Heart, but all of the other images from the Bible and our Catholic Tradition were created by our students. Our Middle School students broke the tiles for him and were very involved from start to finish. The mural has been a work of love for everyone involved and it is one of those special creations that the longer you gaze at it, the more you see.

Dear Parish Family,

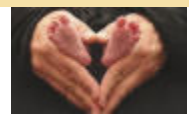
So here we are again, speaking about one of the hottest button issues we have within our nation, that of abortion. I told the congregation on Saturday during my homily, “I dislike speaking about this topic just as much, if not more, than you like listening to it in Mass.” And so why does this hot button issue keep coming up? Because our nation keeps bringing it up, not so much with horror, but with jubilation each and every time progress is made regarding the rights of women AND men who believe that they have a right to decide whether or not the child they have conceived should live or die. When New York passed this latest abortion law, Governor Cuomo and many within the State of New York lit up the World Trade Center in Pink and started partying “like it was 1999” in order to celebrate their latest victory, a victory for them, but not much for the CHILDREN who will be the VICTIMS of this new law.

Governor Cuomo stated, “Today we are taking a giant step forward in the hard-fought battle to ensure a woman’s right to make her own decisions about her own personal health, including the ability to access an abortion. With the signing of this bill, we are sending a clear message that whatever happens in Washington, women in New York will always have the fundamental right to control their own body,” said Governor Andrew Cuomo after signing New York’s Reproductive Health Act on Tuesday night.”

Governor Andrew Cuomo, who is supposedly a Catholic, at least in name *only*, is a strong advocate that women should have the “fundamental right to control their own bodies,” which only goes to show that he is not a strong Christian and/or Catholic, because if he was, he would know from Scripture, Tradition and the Church that none of us, male or female, married or single, clergy or lay have the right to control our own body if controlling our own body goes against and defies the gospel which states that we are not our own—our bodies do not belong to us; they belong to God: “Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been bought with a price; therefore glorify God in your body” (1 Corinthians 6:19-20).

A popular slogan within our society which promotes, “pro-choice” states, “This is my body, and therefore, I can do what I want with it!” Fr. Frank Pavone has stated that this phrase is the complete antithesis of Jesus’ proclamation, “This is my body, and I give it up for you!” When we as men and women say, “This is my body and I can do what I want with it, we usually say it out of selfishness and not with the intention of thinking about the baby in the womb or the community in general; however, when Jesus says, “This is my body and I give it for you,” he says it with the intention of laying down his life for all of us, and that’s why we as men and women are also called to lay down our lives for others: “Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?”

In our First Reading this coming weekend for the 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time, God reminds us through Jeremiah just how sacred each and every life is right from the womb, for he tells the Prophet Jeremiah, “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I dedicated you, a prophet to the nations I appointed you.” May we as Christians and non-Christians, Republicans and Democrats, males and females stand up for LIFE, for the unborn, for the under-dog, for the voice-less, knowing that God has a plan and purpose for each and every CHILD! 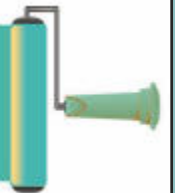
