### Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes February 11

The Marian apparitions occurred in 1858 in the vicinity of Lourdes in France. The first of these apparition occurred on 11 February 1858, when 14-year old Bernadette Soubirous told her mother that a "lady" spoke to her in the cave of Massabielle while she was gathering firewood with her sister and a friend. The apparitions of the "Lady" were reported on seventeen occasions that year, until revelation of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception took place. On 3 July 1876, the Pope Pius IX granted a Canonical Coronation to the image that used to be in the courtyard of what is now part of the Rosary Basilica.

Bernadette Soubirous was canonized as a Catholic saint by Pius XI on 8 December 1933.



### Put out into deep water

Enticed with the promise that the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises could strength belief, two members of our parish ventured across the Wasatch Valley to St Thomas More Catholic Church for a 3-day retreat. It was led by Catherine Morgan, PhD., certified Ignatian spiritual director, and Ralph Morgan, M.A., Ignatian spiritual companion. Here's a little summary of the retreat.

**Spiritual direction** is about being guided in paying attention to God's personal communications, growing in intimacy with God, and living in relationship with God.

**Ignatian Spirituality** is finding God in all things through prayer, discernment, and action.

**The Beliefs of Ignatian Spirituality** include: God is with me in the present moment (and not by coincidence). God is active and involved in my life. God created all things and is present in all things. God is in charge and I am to surrender to God's Will. Everything is a gift from God. In other word, God loves us, continually creates us, and wants to share life with us forever. Our response to God takes shape in our praise, honor, and service.

**Ignatian spiritual exercises** help identify **choice points** which either draw us closer to God or push us away from him. As we incorporate Ignatian exercises into our prayer, we begin to alter bad habits that push us away from God.

**The tools of the Ignatian Exercises** include meditation, contemplation, and pondering. **Meditation** uses the mind and intellect in prayer. **Contemplation** uses the senses and imagination in a prayer encounter based on Scripture. **Pondering** uses meditation and contemplation to find the gift of God in our afflictions. Modeled on the Blessed Mother Mary who pondered things in her heart at Jesus' birth and at the foot of the cross, we place ourselves in the events described in Scripture and allow the Holy Spirit to transform our thinking, feelings, and prayers as we seek to discover God's Will for us and the strength He has given us to cope with our afflictions.

So, in keeping with this Sunday's Gospel, Ignatian Spirituality invites us to strengthen our faith by putting out into the deep: prayerfully boarding a fishing boat with the apostles, casting our fishing nets even though we might be exhausted, and becoming fishers of men and women.

Come along, it is a great adventure!

Dear Parish Family,

The latest Attorney General report from Texas regarding sexual abuse by priests only goes to show that we as Catholic priests need to step up to the plate and acknowledge these crimes. Whether we are innocent or guilty, we, as Catholic priests, need to stand up and speak out against the sexual abuse of children by Catholic priests:

“Take no part in the fruitless works of darkness; rather expose them, for it is shameful even to mention those things done by them in secret; but everything exposed by the light becomes visible, for everything that becomes visible is light. Therefore, it says: ‘Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light.’” (Ephesians 5:11-14).

As priests, let us acknowledge the sins (the crimes) committed within our ranks by recognizing that this is the not the time to defend the priesthood or the Catholic Church, but the time to recognize the harm that has been caused to the victims, to their families, to their future generations, to the Church and to Christianity as a whole. No apology or no amount of restitution will ever be able to restore the innocence that was stolen by a Catholic priest through the Catholic Church when he should have been a pastor protecting his flock, rather than a wolf in sheep’s clothing.

Scripture is clear—God will not be mocked: “Therefore, shepherds, hear the word of the Lord: As I live, says the Lord God, because my sheep have been given over to pillage, and because my sheep have become food for every wild beast, for lack of a shepherd; because my shepherds did not look after my sheep, but pastured themselves and did not pasture my sheep; because of this, shepherds, hear the word of the Lord: Thus says the Lord God: I swear I am coming against these shepherds. I will claim my sheep from them and put a stop to their shepherding my sheep so that they may no longer pasture themselves. I will save my sheep” (Ezekiel 34: 7-10).

May each and every one of us in the Catholic priesthood, from the pope himself all the way down to me, listen to this message loudly and clearly and TAKE HEED! -- Fr. Ken
