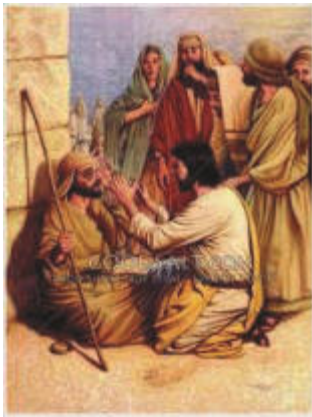

#### AN INVITATION OF LOVE

Need an invitation to go to confession? Have you considered extending an invitation to family and friends who may wish to go? If we remember nothing else from our childhood catechism classes, it should be that we may always, always return to the Lord by making a good Confession, no matter how long it has been since the last time.

Monday, April 1 is a special day at Saint Marguerite. It is a day in which we "turn on the lights" for all to return to the sacrament of Reconciliation. Starting at 7 PM with a brief Liturgy of the Word, 8 priests will be available to show us God's unconditional, never-ending, merciful love.

With the authority of the Church to absolve us from our sins, they will listen without judging, give guidance to avoid future sin, listen to our contrition prayer, and pray over us with these words:

*God, the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen*

At some point in our lives, we can probably admit to avoiding confession for a long time, maybe even years. I can relate. At the time of my life when I was most self-confident that I didn't need to go to Church, I stayed away. For a little more than 9 years, I did things "my way" and made more mistakes in those years than I care to remember.

What I do remember is deciding to come back! I chose a Saturday afternoon so that I could go to Mass and receive Communion right afterward. Yes, I was nervous. Yes, I was anxious. But, the desire to get myself right with God and the people in my life was strong.

While I don't remember the priest's name, I do remember that he told me God loves me now and that God loved me the entire time I was away, and God loved me even when I was doing wrong. The words of absolution poured over me like warm water. I felt loved and forgiven; strong and willing to do God's will; ready to begin life anew.

So, please consider everyone in your life who may need to get back in touch with God's love and invite them to our Parish Reconciliation Service. As Father Ken has reminded us since he arrived at Saint Marguerite: *I'm sorry, I was wrong, please forgive me*, are great sentiments that we need to live by.

Come to Confession. The light is on. All are welcome.

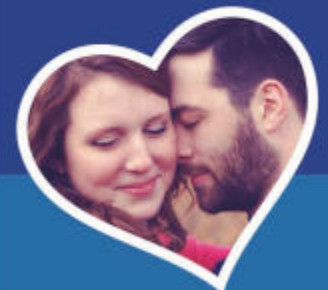
