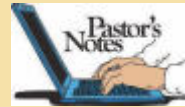

Dear Parish Family,

It's not uncommon for newspaper reporters to misquote the people they are covering in their article, which can definitely change the tone of the whole article if reporters are not careful to get the exact quote and/or message from the one they are reporting about.

In the Lord's wisdom, he made sure that he wasn't going to be misquoted, especially when it came to the message about his death and resurrection, and so he chose 12 gifted reporters, 12 Apostles who would be able to give an exact account of where he went, what he said, and what he did from the very beginning of his three year ministry to the very end when he took his last breath there on the cross, to mention forty days after his resurrection where he showed himself to Mary Magdalene, the other women, and 500 other eye-witnesses who saw him all at once.

Jesus knew that throughout his ministry, throughout all of his miracles, and throughout his suffering, death and resurrection, he was going to be misquoted, misrepresented and misunderstood, not by one reporter, but by a mob of people, which would include the Romans, the Jewish authorities and by many others up through the centuries.

Although Jesus had made a few friends along the way, he had many who were against him, including the Pharisees and the Scribes who didn't want to believe the truth, know the truth or report the truth, but instead, tried to bribe the Roman guards into saying that Jesus didn't rise from the dead; the disciples "stole" his body while the guards were asleep. In the Gospel of Matthew, Matthew reports how the press ran with this story because he states, "The soldiers bought into this bribe; the soldiers took the money and did as they were instructed, and this story has circulated among the Jews to the present day."

This all sounds like bad news, but thanks to God, bad reporting, false accusations and rumors do not get the last word. Our Lord who was led to the slaughter like a lamb without opening his mouth gets the last word, especially through all the resurrection accounts that we find in Scripture. From the Gospel of Matthew, we hear, "And behold, there was an earthquake, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, approached, rolled back the stone, and sat upon it. His appearance was like lightening and his clothing was white as snow. The guards were shaken with fear of him and became like dead men, then the angel said to the women in reply. Do not be afraid! I know that you are seeking Jesus the crucified. He is not here, for he has been raised, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples He has been raised from the dead, and he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him. Behold, I have told you" (Matthew 28:2-7).

Although you and I were not eye-witnesses to the resurrection of the Lord just as the 12 Apostles, Mary Magdalene, the other women and the 500 witnesses were, we have accurate reporting from their accounts according to Scripture, so let us run forth announcing this GOOD NEWS to the world! Happy Easter!
