From Supper to Service, with Thanks

Looking back to the message of Holy Thursday to the Baptismal Promises we renewed on Easter Sunday, and to the command to "Go out and share the Good News" at the end of every Mass, we take a moment today to say a heartfelt **thank you** to our fellow parishioners for sharing their talents in our Lenten and Holy Week liturgies.

Over the past two months, many parishioners have been immersed in final planning and preparations for these special liturgies. These faith celebrations don't just happen because we all "show up" on Sunday morning!

As explained in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the liturgy, which includes the Mass (among other services), is something that "the whole Christ", Head and Body, celebrates and prepares — Christ, the one High Priest, together with his Body, the Church in heaven and on earth.

The word *liturgy* is from the Greek *leitourgia* which means "the work of the people" or "work on behalf of the people". In other words, it's the community coming together with all their talent to celebrate the presence of God among us in friendship.

We may be used to thinking of talent as playing a musical instrument or doing something artistic, yet as we build up the Body of Christ through our parish worship, we need a wide range of talents: good listeners, good cooks, cooperative team members, fastidious cleaners, organizers, readers, servers, inviters, people who make great coffee, people to serve doughnuts and coffee, people willing to study Scripture and teach catechism classes, singers, musicians, decorators, and more.

For the past 50 years, the Church has called us to *full, active and conscious participation* in our liturgies. In other words, each of us has something to contribute to making our worship beautiful and meaningful.

In a recent article on Facebook, the Sisters of Mercy of America wrote: "The act of foot washing in John's Gospel is also about the mutual service of friendship, and a sharing of ourselves and our gifts in a way that eschews any sort of power or dominance. On Holy Thursday [and moving forward], as we stand poised on the threshold of Easter, let us continue to celebrate our friendship, strengthen one another for service, and delight in the ever-present Mercy of our God."

Thank you, dear faith friends, for your service in our liturgies, for your friendship, and for sharing your talents.
