

Dear Parish Family,

I don't think that it's accidental or coincidental, but providential that on the 4<sup>th</sup> Week of Easter, we get to celebrate two themes: The Good

Shepherd and Mother's Day! For some, it might be a stretch to connect these two roles, a *shepherd* and a *mother*, but for most people, it's not that far of a stretch because how many of our mothers, along with our fathers, were there to "shepherd" us or to guide, guard and protect us every step of the way.

There is a spiritual teaching that says, "When we get to heaven, we are not going to be surprised that we have always known the Good Shepherd, for we will know *then* that the Good Shepherd was present with us through the shepherding and pastoring of our parents, who like the Good Shepherd, led us to those greener pastures and refreshing waters."

In our gospel today, we hear Jesus tell us, "My sheep hear my voice." It's fair to say that on the day a child is born, he immediately clings to the sound of the mother's voice, not because he hears it for the first time, but because he grew to love and depend on that voice from the minute he received that sense of hearing within the womb. Mothers and Father's may play music while the child is in the womb, and the child may develop a connection with those sounds, but it's the mother's voice that the child clings to, first and foremost, because of the familiarity.

Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice. I know them and they follow me." Like a lamb who listens to the voice of the shepherd and will follow the shepherd wherever it goes, the newborn baby, infant, toddler, child and/or teenager will automatically cling to, hold on to and follow the mother (to a certain degree) because of the symbiotic relationship that has been formed over the years. Of course, as the child matures, he learns to separate from his mother and to develop his own autonomy, but deep within his heart, there is still a loyalty to his mother and to his father, along with a willingness to follow his mother or father, wherever they lead!

After Jesus tells us that his sheep hear his voice and follow him, he tells us, "I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish." We all know, of course, that it is the Good Shepherd who gives us eternal life, but we cannot forget that we would not have that gift of physical, spiritual and eternal life if our parents hadn't been willing to cooperate with God's gift of creation. We owe a debt of gratitude to God and to our parents for this gift of LIFE!

Within this gospel, Jesus proclaims the strong TIE he has with us that cannot and should not be broken for he say, "No one shall snatch them out of my hand." As we celebrate Mother's Day this weekend, may we thank all of our Mothers who physically and figuratively grasped us by the hand and would not let us go in order to protect us from any potential danger or harm that was out there, not to mention the "big bad wolf!" As we celebrate the Good Shepherd and Mother's Day this weekend, let us thank our mothers for being a great reflection of the Good Shepherd!
