### **The Catholic Way to Cook a Hamburger?**

In his 2007 speech at Villanova University, Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia declared there is no such thing as a Catholic judge, just as there is no Catholic way to cook a hamburger. If that is true, then I wonder how he would have answered Pope Saint John Paul II's questions:



*"What have I done with my baptism and confirmation? Is Christ really at the center of my life? Do I have time for prayer in my life? Do I live my life as a vocation and mission?"*

Last night (May 28), many of us watched **America's Got Talent** in which a young man from Tooele, Kodi Lee, earned the coveted *Golden Buzzer*. Although blind and autistic, he sang and played piano with a passion that invited us all to enter into the moment. His mother was at his side, guiding him to the piano as he performed a rendition of "A Song for You" by Donny Hathaway. Clearly his gifts as a savant were nurtured by many people: family, friends, teachers, and more, as he is being praised across countless Facebook posts in Tooele today.

Pentecost can be a time in which we reflect on the accomplishments of our parish and the People of God in Tooele and hope for our future. Our parish will be 109 years old this year. It has produced 5 priestly vocations, a good number of deacons, birthed a nursery into an accredited Catholic elementary school, helped a mission church become a self-sustaining parish, administered thousands of baptisms, confirmations, communions, weddings, and \_\_\_\_\_. Let's fill in the blank with more of our Golden Buzzer moments!

Tooele County is growing rapidly, and it looks like it will continue to grow in the near future with the housing shortage in the Wasatch Valley. So, what will we do with this opportunity? How will we grow our parish? How will we renew ourselves? Will there be more Golden Buzzer moments for us? Or are we thinking our Catholic faith has nothing to do with the way we live our lives?



Scripture tells us the love, mercy and graces of God are new every morning (Lamentations 3: 22-23). With the renewal offered by our celebration of Pentecost each year, we can count on the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit to help renew the way we live our commission to share the Good News of the Gospel, sing a song or even cook a hamburger.

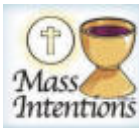
