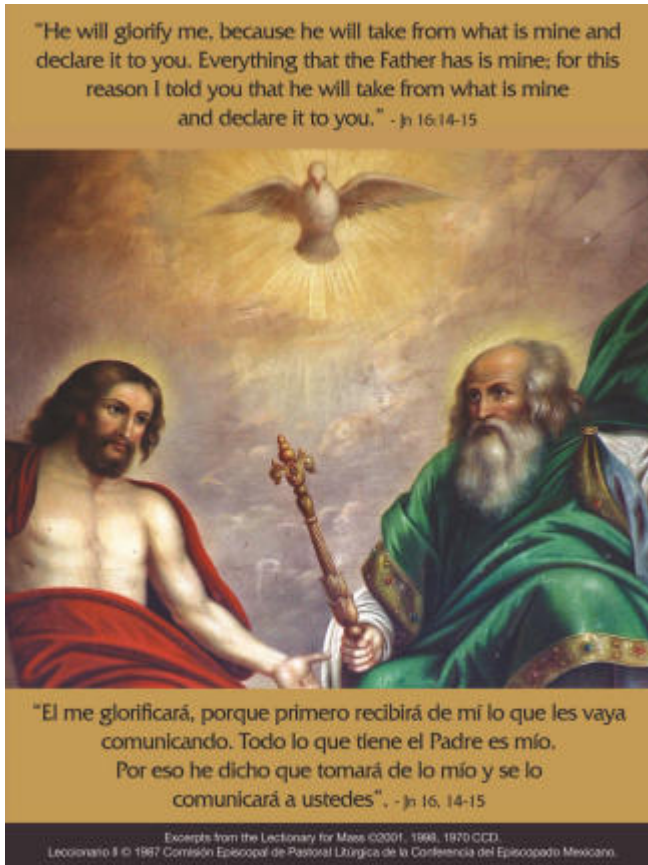

Mystery, Trinity, and Unity: The Blessed Trinity in our Parish

There are two ways to think about the Trinity: first, to consider the being and nature of God as three persons and one substance and second, to reflect on the ways God relates to us and works through our humanity. The first way is mysterious and difficult to comprehend, while the second is challenging to apply in our daily lives, so let's take the second approach.

Our fellow parishioners give us many opportunities to mirror the relationships within the Trinity. We have what's called a "shared parish" in which people of many cultures – Guamanians, Filipinos, New Mexicans, Italians, Mexicans, Irish, Nigerians, and more – mix together, worship together, and often hold events unique to their cultures. More, we have a rich mix of people of all ages, including every single personality type.

Our encounters with each other give us countless opportunities to express the love of God. To guide our interactions, we may look to the Trinity as the ideal image to inspire sharing and relating in a parish community.

The Trinity is the creative relationship of love and unity between the Father, the Son, and Holy Spirit, theologian Karl Barth explains. He says God the Father in the Trinity is "for others" because his "essence is sharing". Professor Roberto Goizueta explains Christ in the Trinity as a brother who mourns with us, dies with us, touches us sacramentally, hopes with us and unites us. Michael Connors reminds us that through the Holy Spirit, we become more aware of the various and plentiful gifts of all the church's members, we are empowered for service, and we grow in solidarity with those who are poor or marginalized.

Last week our soon-to-be pastor, Father Rafael Murillo, wrote, "As a new pastor of Saint Marguerite, I am coming to accompany you on your journey of faith and to make Jesus Christ present through my ministry." This insight leads us to the knowledge that Father Rafael understands we walk together on the journey of life to learn about God and how to extend our sacramental encounters with Christ in parish life to others. In this way, he will be guiding us on our mission to "Go out to all the world and share the Good News."

The Trinity is our model of relationships, empowerment, accompaniment, justice, and stewardship. Knowing that God loves us, comes to us, and seeks to live in relationship with us is essential to our Christian lives (Pedraja). The doctrine of the Trinity exemplifies how God accompanies us in Christ and in the Spirit. Through them we never walk alone (Pedraja). Thus, the Trinity offers us a lofty ideal for our parish.

Dear Parish Family,

In Cardinal Donald Wuerl's book called, "Faith that Transforms Us: Reflections of the Creed," Cardinal Wuerl states that "The Most Holy Trinity is the central and most profound mystery of the Christian faith and life. While we human beings can grasp certain aspects of this ultimate truth about God, precisely as a mystery, a full understanding is beyond our limited human comprehension.

Wuerl writes that "The essential elements of this divine mystery are that we worship one God who is an eternal loving communion of three Persons--Father, Son and Holy Spirit—who are all equal in power, all co-eternal, and all divine. One divine nature, they differ only in that the Father is not the Son; the Son is not the Father; the Spirit is not the Son; the Spirit is not the Father. While this mystery of one and yet three might at first seem contradictory and irrational by human reckoning, if we delve deeper, we will find, like the other paradoxes of the faith, an amazing and profoundly life-changing truth.

"The doctrine of the Trinity can perhaps best be understood by Scripture's most compact definition of God: "God is love" (1 John 4:8). Love is by its very nature a relationship—it requires an "other." The fullness of love is also by its very nature unitive. More than a mere association of individual persons, in the fullness of love there is a *communion* of persons—the multiplicity become one."

The Catholic Author G.K. Chesterton observed that the Trinity is "simply the logical side of love." Within God himself is Someone who **loves** and Someone who is **loved**, and there is the **Love**, who is reality as well. There is the Father and the Son, and the love which proceeds from them is not merely some warm sentiment, but a Person, the Holy Spirit."

Dad, as we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity this week, we want to thank you for being a powerful reflection of the **love** that is shared between the Father and the Son, which in turn, generates the Holy Spirit. Your love, guidance and protection has been a constant factor in our lives, and therefore has formed and transformed us into the people that we are today. May the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit continue to bless you, now and forever! **HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!**

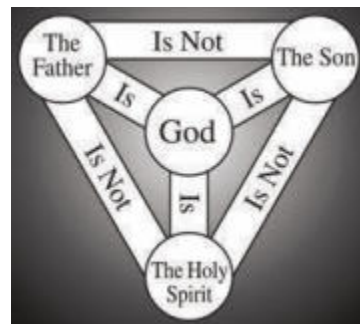
