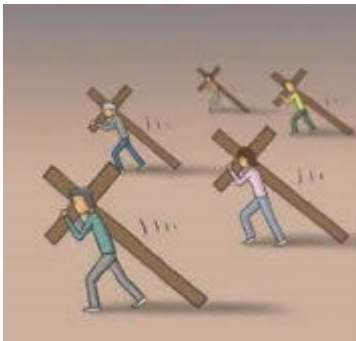

What are we doing to increase our faith and confirm our hope?

There is a great opportunity on the horizon that is the perfect answer: **The Pastoral Congress**. Some of our parishioners have attended this annual event in the past; however, some have never gone. This year, we are encouraged by Bishop Solis and Father Rafael to give it a try.

"What a beautiful expression of unity and solidarity, to be together, learning how we can make ourselves better disciples of Christ and ministers of the Gospel," the Intermountain Catholic quotes Bishop Solis as saying.

Keynote speakers will be talking about evangelization and missionary discipleship and three Saint Marguerite parishioners will be speaking about evangelization and formation in a parish setting.

Rosario Tovar, José Arreola, and Lorena Needham have been invited to share their experience of and hopes for parish evangelization at the Congress. Rosario and Jose both have had unique experiences through the recent V Encuentro (5th Encounter) process and Lorena has researched the nearly 30-year Encuentro (encounter) process and the many ways it can help a parish grow in unity and solidarity.

Father Rafael, our new pastor, has given his blessing for this talk, along with development of a parish plan to reach out to our youth and to Catholics in the local community to return to the practice of the faith in our wonderful parish. While the details of this proposed year-long plan for faith formation are still under development, this trio of missionaries is excited about the possibilities for increasing our focus on youth, in particular.

Moreover, with Tooele County being the 7th fastest growing county in the United States, there is a great need to open our arms to welcome newcomers.

So, while the Pastoral Congress will be giving us the opportunity to hear great speakers on different themes of faith, hope, evangelization, and catechesis, our representatives will be presenting their ideas on how to apply these themes to bring growth to our parish.

These are exciting times in Tooele County, in Utah, and in the Diocese of Salt Lake City. The love of God is calling us to action – to proclaim the Gospel and to live Gospel values here and now.

So, don't miss the 2019 Pastoral Congress on Saturday, September 15!

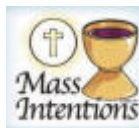
